




## AN EASTERN IOWA WELCOME

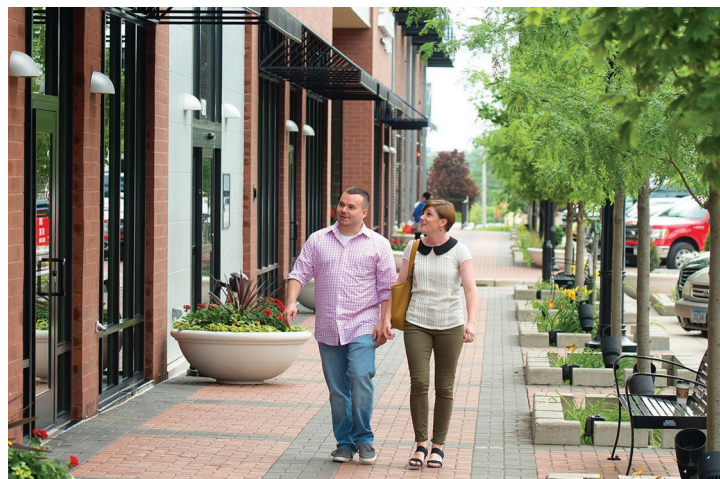
## OUR CURIOUS COMMUNITIES

Located at the crossroads of Interstate 80 (San Francisco to New York) and Interstate 380/Highway 218 (St. Paul to St. Louis), Iowa City is a convenient trip from major metro areas.

The Eastern Iowa Airport (CID) is located just 20 miles north of the Iowa City area. CID serviced over 1.2 million passengers in 2018 and offers 11 non-stop destinations year-round. The Quad City International Airport (MLI) is located 65 miles to the east of Iowa City in Moline. Airlines include American, Allegiant, Delta, and United with 11 nonstop cities and connections beyond.
