

Flurries & Fun at Brian Head Resort



A 3-Day weekend getaway on the slopes at Brian Head Resort

Enjoy starry skies and snowy sights surrounded by the classic red rock of southern Utah with a getaway to Brian Head, Kanarrville, and beyond.

SEASON: NOVEMBER - MARCH

Day One: *Brian Head, UT*

AFTERNOON

- Arrive in Brian Head and check into your lodging.
- With lift passes and rentals reserved ahead of time, hit the slopes at Brian Head Resort
- Grab lunch at Last Chair Grill & Bar

EVENING

- After dinner glide through the trees with ice skating at Brian Head Ice
 - Tickets are \$15 for children and \$20 for adults with skate rentals available for \$5
- Enjoy dinner and drinks at Pizanos Pizzeria
- Bundle up and head to the North Overlook of Cedar Breaks for some outstanding night sky views.
 - If you are arriving on a Saturday, guided dark sky tours with park rangers are available starting at 5:30 pm

Day Two: *Brian Head & Cedar City*

MORNING

- Start the day with a snowmobile tour with Thunder Mountain Motorsports.
 - The three-hour tour starts at 9 am and takes you to incredible scenery around Brian Head

AFTERNOON

- After the tour pack up and head down the canyon to the Parowan Gap Petroglyphs.
- Continue to Cedar City and grab lunch in Historic Downtown.
- Visit the Southern Utah Museum of Art to see rotating exhibits and a building inspired by Utah's slot canyons and dazzling night skies.

EVENING

- Enjoy a wine tasting at IG Winery and dinner at The Pub Spirits + Craft Kitchen.
- Continue on to overnight lodging in Kanarrville.
 - Detour to Kolob Canyons (the north side of Zion National Park) to catch incredible night sky views

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Day Three: *Kanarrville, Utah*

MORNING

- Bundle up and head out for a guided horseback tour with Rising K Ranch horseback rides.
 - We recommend booking The Cedar Trail Ride for the best views. A 1 1/2 hour ride, you'll have a brief horseback riding lesson before the ride.
 - Morning options include a 9 am and 10:30 am start time

AFTERNOON

- After the tour stop for lunch at Fire + Smoke BBQ
- On your way home, stop at Kolob Canyons again to take in the daytime views of snow on the crimson cliffs. The five-mile scenic drive is a must-see in winter.

Why Utah Dark Skies?

- ✓ Utah has the highest concentration of certified International Dark Sky Parks & Communities.
- ✓ April was declared Dark Sky Month by Utah Governor Cox in 2021
- ✓ All 5 of Utah's National Parks are designated dark sky parks
- ✓ Dark sky parks closest to Cedar City include: Cedar Breaks National Monument, Zion National park, and Bryce Canyon National Park
- ✓ Some of our favorite stargazing spots include: Three Peaks Recreation Area, Kolob Canyons, Wood Ranch Recreation Area
