

The museum's mission is to "inspire minds through nature and science." The 180,000-square-foot museum stands approximately 170 feet high, which is equivalent to approximately 14 stories. A significant feature is the 54-foot escalator contained in a 150-foot glass-enclosed tube-like structure that dramatically extends outside the building. The exhibit halls feature video and 3D computer animation with thrilling, life-like simulation. Tabletop landscapes and computergenerated flyovers provide eye-popping enhancement supported with timely, relevant and engaging lessons and programs. Hands-on activities, interactive kiosks and educational games engage and excite visitors of every age. Additionally, visitors experience amazing paleontology displays, large collections of ornithology and taxidermy, and beautiful gems and minerals, to name a few. Day 1
