JACKSON HOLE ART WALKS

From 5:00-8:00 p.m., downtown galleries welcome visitors to stroll from one creative space to the next, enjoying extended evening hours, artist demonstrations, live music, refreshments, and special exhibitions. Each Art Walk offers a unique opportunity to connect with local artists, explore diverse collections, and experience the community that helped earn Jackson Hole recognition as America's most arts-vibrant community. 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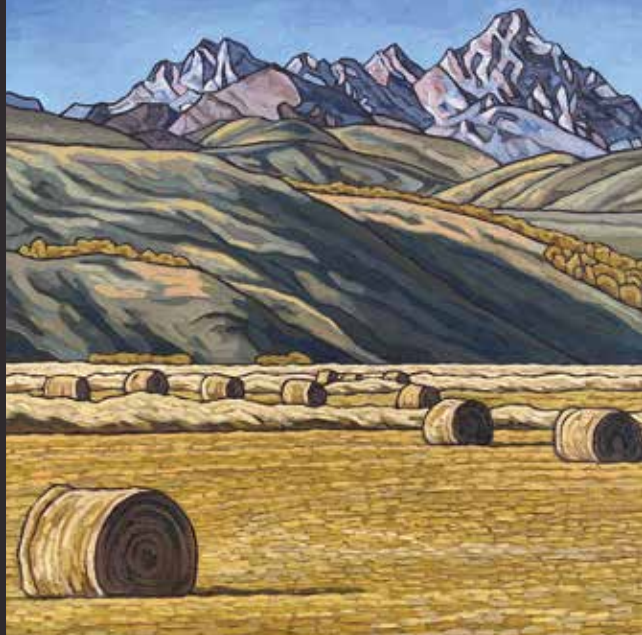

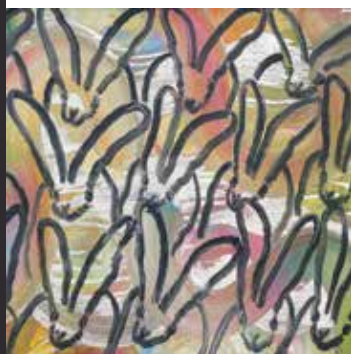

GALLERY WILD

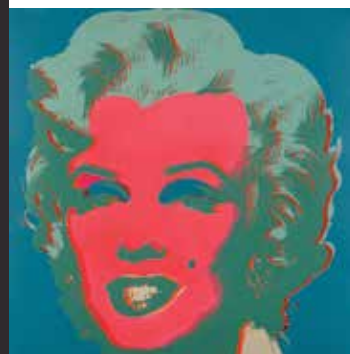

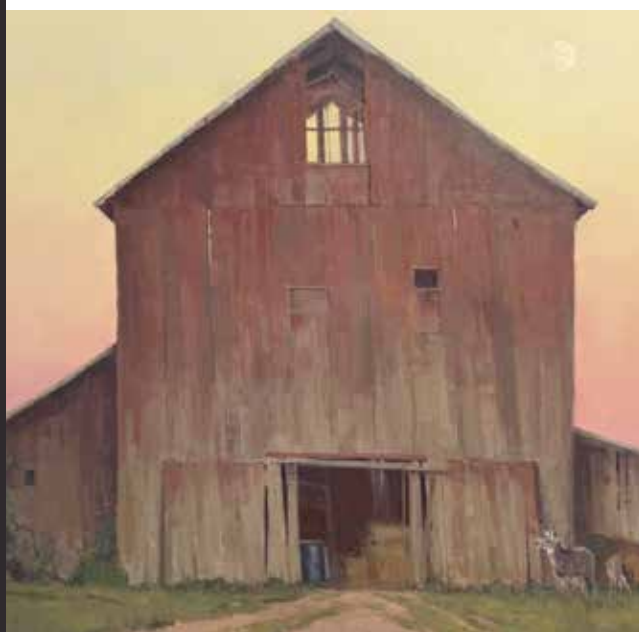

JACKSON HOLE HISTORY MUSEUM

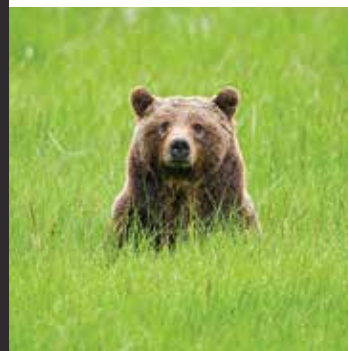


Explore 11,000+ years of Jackson Hole history through engaging, interactive exhibits. Visit two historic cabins, including one highlighting the valley's movie-making past. In the Main Gallery, discover pull-out drawers with hands-on artifacts, interactive kiosks featuring Photo and Artifact Walls, and videos that bring local stories to life, from Indigenous peoples and mountain men to early settlers, ranchers, and conservationists. Upstairs, rotating exhibits co-curated with community organizations and regional partners offer fresh perspectives with each visit. Families can enjoy self-guided activities in the Classroom, while researchers may schedule time in the Archives to explore the Museum's collection.
