## TETON COUNTY'S UNIFIED MESSAGE

**THE TOWN OF JACKSON, GRAND TETON NATIONAL PARK, YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK, AND THE BRIDGER-TETON NATIONAL FOREST ARE OPEN THROUGH THE REMAINDER OF THE SEASON.**

The Federal Government has passed a short-term funding bill, keeping federal services and national lands open. Jackson Hole and surrounding national lands remain open to visitors with full services through the remainder of the season. Many park services, including park roads, close for the 2023 season between October 9 and October 20, 2023.

In the Fall, Jackson and surrounding areas offer miles of outdoor recreation, prime wildlife viewing, and beautiful scenic routes alongside dining, shopping, and entertainment. Some featured experiences can be found below or by calling our Visitor Services agents at (307)733-3316.
