### Stop by, Say Hello, and Ask Questions

The Chamber of Commerce has three Visitor Centers in town. They have information on lodging, dining, and activities, as well as road and weather updates, restrooms, and more.

Visitor Center locations are marked with the information symbols above. Park at our Home Ranch Welcome Center at 210 North Cache Street, after which you can walk across the street to the Jackson Hole Historical Society & Museum and then continue to Town Square for a bite to eat.

Or visit the Jackson Hole & Greater Yellowstone Visitor Center that is next to the Elk Refuge at 532 North Cache Street. You can get geared up for your trip with park passes and camping supplies. Enjoy the wildlife films, browse the gift shop's guidebooks and souvenirs, and relax on the wildlife-viewing decks.

### Jackson vs. Jackson Hole

Visitors and locals use the two names interchangeably: Jackson or Jackson Hole. Jackson Hole refers to the nearby towns that make up the area: Jackson, Wilson, Moose, and Teton Village.
