# How to get Married in Jamaica

For those who can't wait to tie the knot, you can be married just 24 hours after arriving. The sooner you provide the Ministry of Justice with your marriage license application, the sooner you can start your new life together. Wedding coordinators at most hotels will make these arrangements for you. However, if you elect to do it yourself, that's OK, too—just submit the application here:

## REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Unlike many countries, Jamaica does not require a blood test before marriage. However, the following documentation is required:

- Proof of citizenship
- Certified copy of your birth certificate, which includes the father's name
- Parents' written consent if under 18 years of age
- Proof of divorce, if applicable (original certificate of divorce)
- Certified copy of death certificate for widow or widower

All documents that are not issued in English must be translated by an official translator and subsequently certified by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the country of residence and by the nearest Jamaican Mission or Honorary Consulate.

## PROCESSING FEE

The processing fee for the marriage license is \$4,000\* JMD (approximately U.S. \$50). This fee is included in the price quoted for most, if not all, hotel wedding packages. Marriage licenses are valid for three months.
