18th century sugar mill ruins, aqueducts and stone walls run adorn its greens. Ask your Caddy about the famous mansion on the 19th hole!

Hall sugar plantation. Noted for its spectacular views,
the signature 17th hole was selected as the Shell's
Wonderful World of Golf's signature hole for the fall
2000 television series. This par 3 plays from 130 to
161 yards and its tabletop green is fringed by sand
traps!
