Emancipation Park

A 7-acre public park with fountains and art commemorating the end of slavery.

Mational Heroes Park

A 50-acre botanical garden which is also the burial site of many of Jamaica's National Heroes, Prime Ministers, and cultural luminaries.

Kingston Harbour

Home to the largest shipping port in the Caribbean, this harbour is the world's 7th largest, and once the hub for 17th century pirate ships.

Creative Art Walk District

Holy Trinity Cathedral

This 112 years old cathedral is one of the Caribbean's most impressive landmarks.
