Jamaica has long been a meeting planner's dream and continues to score top marks due to its location. The destination is a favorite given its energy, flair and warm hospitality which ensures your corporate event, retreat or convention is unforgettable.

Access

Getting to Jamaica has never been easier. With air service from most major gateways in the United States, you can choose to arrive at any of the island's three international airports. Unlike other destinations, a tourist visa is not required for U.S. passport holders, expediting the pre-trip process and making booking large corporate conferences much easier. Depending on your meeting location, planners may choose to arrive Kingston or Montego Bay and can now easily connect via the scenic North-South highway corridor. Private buses are available for charter for large groups.

Airlift

Jamaica has seen an increase in airline seats from the United States, making the destination easier to get to. For the period May-December 2018, the destination secured a total of 1.6 million airline seats from various U.S. gateways to Kingston and Montego Bay. This is an increase over last year's 1.4 million air seats. With the increasing demand of travel to Jamaica, several airlines have increased daily service from popular U.S. gateways for Kingston and Montego Bay.

Airports

The Jamaican experience starts on arrival, whether in Kingston at the Norman Manley International Airport or Montego Bay at the Sangster International Airport. In September, operators of Sangster International commenced a transformation project to not only improve infrastructure with the latest technology, but also positioning MBJ as a bastion of Jamaican culture through interior design upgrades to reflect the island's natural beauty, while the store fronts will be revitalized to feature unique Jamaican products.

Arrive in style

What better way to begin your Jamaican travel experience than with personalized expedited service through the airport? For a small fee, enjoy 'Fast Track', a hassle-free process that quickly takes you through immigration and customs. Afterwards, you'll be taken straight to VIP Attractions in Kingston or Montego Bay premium lounge where a range of comforts await you, from large screen TVs, refreshing drinks and delicious snacks to private restrooms, newspapers and magazines, all while you wait for a member of their team to notify you when your transportation to your accommodations on the island has arrived to pick you up.

Attractions

There's so much to do even if you're on business. After a long day of meetings, there is a variety of activities to enjoy and numerous attractions for groups of all sizes. There's no shortage of things to do whether it's a group rafting session down the Martha Brae River in Trelawny, or taking a zipline/bobsled tour of the jungles of Mystic Mountain overlooking Ocho Rios. APPLICATION FOR WAIVER OF DUTIES/BOND:

Should you wish to make your event even more special by including material and equipment brought from abroad – such as gifts, trophies, etc– you will need to apply to the Ministry of Finance for a waiver of customs duties and bonds. The Jamaica Tourist Board Groups and Conventions Department will be happy to help you through this process. Your application must be received no fewer than 20 working days before the date of shipment and travel.

TAX DEDUCTION STATUS

U.S. Public Law 96-608 and Jamaica's Exemption

On December 16, 1981, the U.S. Senate passed a protocol to the Income Tax Treaty with Jamaica. According to the protocol, expenses incurred by a citizen or resident of the United States in connection with attendance at a convention, seminar or similar meeting held in Jamaica shall be deductible for the purpose of taxation in the United States to the same extent as if the convention, seminar or similar meeting were held in the United States.
