

FUN FACTS ABOUT JAMAICA

Jamaica is well known as a place which heals the mind, body and soul. Many visitors come to our shores to put aside the hustle and bustle of daily life and bask in the warmth of our people; the tranquility of our island vistas and soothe their souls. But did you know that this healing of the physical body is a literal healing? Oh yes! Jamaica is blessed with naturally occurring mineral spas, which have been proven to contain healing properties. Here are a few of the more famous ones.

 Milk River Bath, Clarendon, Located on the banks of the milk river in Clarendon on Jamaica's south-central coast, it was officially opened to the public in 1974. The waters have a radioactivity of 16m curries per litre, which is about 50 times as radioactive as the waters of Vichy in France; and 54 times as radioactive as the waters of Baden in Switzerland! www.milkriverbath.com



- Doctor's Cave Bathing Beach, Montego Bay. Many would know this as a popular resort area beach but it was Sir Herbert Barker - a British Osteopath - who in the 1920 discovered the healing powers of the waters here. Since then it has been a meca for celebrities and regulars alike. www.doctorscavebathingclub.com
- Rockfort Mineral Bath, Kingston. Rockfort Mineral bath is one of the oldest public facilities in Jamaica. The therapeutic properties of the mineral-rich waters flow from the Rockfort Hills above it and is believed to have surfaced after the devastating Port Royal earthquake of 1907.
