


REYNOLDS PIER GETS NEW **FISHERMAN'S VILLAGE!**

H₁₀ HOTELS & RESORTS TO OPEN NEW PROPERTY IN NOVEMBER!

H10 Resorts & Hotel has announced the construction of its new property in Jamaica, the Oceans Coral Spring. - There are two main types of commercially grown coffee in the world, the Robusta and the Arabica. Guess which type is grown in Jamaica? If you answered Arabia, then you deserve a rich cup of Jamaican Arabica coffee!
- But where did coffee come from? "Kaffe" as it was originally called, originated from the highlands of Ethiopia, by a goat herder who noticed that his goats got a little excited and energized when they ate berries from the plant. British Governor Nicholas Lawes introduced coffee to Jamaica in 1728 and the first exports occurred in 1737. And as they say, the rest is history!
