

KATY TRAIL STATE PARK (FREE)
Built on the former corridor of the Missouri-Kansas-Texas Railroad, the Katy Trail is the longest developed rail-trail in the country.

JEFFERSON LANDING STATE HISTORIC SITE (FREE)
Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, the Lohman Building depicts an 1850s general store and warehouse.

- 1 THE MISSOURI STATE CAPITOL** is not only the center of state government but is literally a 500,000-square-foot museum of public art.
- 2 THE MISSOURI GOVERNOR'S MANSION** is one of the oldest governors' homes in the United States and one of few executive residences that is open to the public.
- 3 THE MISSOURI STATE PENITENTIARY** was the oldest continually operating prison west of the Mississippi River before closing in 2004.

A permanent tribute to the LU founders of the 62nd and 65th Colored Infantries who served in the U.S. Civil War.

A picturesque, tiered fountain honoring Missouri's veterans and their sacrifices to protect liberty for all.

Pedestrians and bicyclists can safely cross the bridge between the heart of the city and north Jefferson City while admiring scenic views.

- 5. LEWIS & CLARK MONUMENT AT THE LEWIS & CLARK TRAILHEAD PLAZA**


