Jerry Stephenson Jr. knows all about intense competition, he enters about 17 to 24 Kansas City Barbeque Society competitions a year. Jerry and his sister (and partner) grew up on a farm in eastern NC and Jerry says he learned his 'que skills from watching others cook whole hogs. He loves the simplicity of the whole hog approach to barbeque, "Low and slow cooking over coals that are burned down from logs. The coals are shoveled into precise places to cook the hog perfectly."
