- 9:30am Start a history lesson at <u>Bentonville Battlefield State Historic Site</u> then follow along the <u>driving pull offs</u> from Bentonville to Smithfield.
- 11:00am One stop on the drive takes you to <u>Howell Woods</u>, where you can explore the walking trails around the learning center, stop by the reptile exhibit, and the birds of prey sanctuary.
- 12:30pm Get a bite to eat at local favorite, The Redneck BBQ Lab, on Hwy 210. Shop in
- 1:30pm <u>Downtown Smithfield</u> for vintage treasures, and several specialty shops.
- 2:30pm Complete your day trip with a visit to the <u>Johnston County Heritage Center</u> or the <u>Ava Gardner Museum</u> for more history on the county or to learn more about the Hollywood legend that was born in Johnston County, just 7 mile east of Smithfield. 	Salvaged Heirlooms, and Royal Boutique for a new outfit.
12Noon	Head to Four Oaks up US HWY 301 and stop in at OGI Design for custom gifts
	and furniture, and another coffee and shopping at Stanfields Country Store and
	Antiques.
1:30pm	Continue up 301 on to Smithfield for shopping at Oak City Collection and you
	might want a snack at one of several restaurants in town like Gotham's Deli,
	SoDoSoPa or The Gilded Pear.
2:30pm	Take a scenic walk along the Neuse River on the <b>Buffalo Creek Greenway</b> , which is
	part of the NC Mountains to the Sea Trail.
3:30pm	Shop for more <u>antiques in Downtown Selma</u> along Raiford Street, and grab a coffee
	or ice cream as you shop. And if you love a music variety show, make plans to
	come back for the Live @ The Rudy shows held all year round.
