


#### **Baseball and Softball**

### 3 Little Pigs Triathlon

Johnston County hosts many different races, the most popular being Smithfield's 3 Little Pigs Triathlon. This annual event is held on the 3rd Saturday in June. The swim is in the beautiful Smithfield Recreation and Aquatics Center (SRAC) in Smithfield, and is a 250 yards pool swim. The 14 mile bike course takes you from the SRAC into rural Johnston County on a scenic, but flat course. The 5k run course is an out-and-back course that will take you through Smithfield's community park and onto the Buffalo Creek Greenway and back to SRAC.
