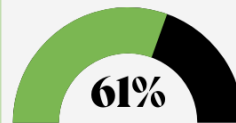

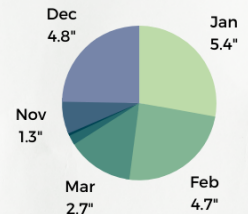

The great part about Kalamazoo being a four seasons city is that it offers activities that compliment each one, including skiing, biking, and hiking to name a few.

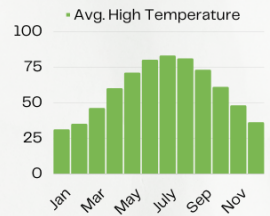


OF DAYS THROUGHOUT THE YEAR
