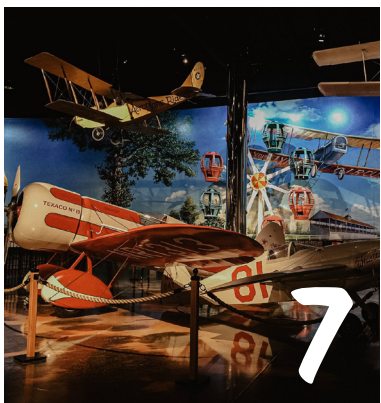
GILMORE CAR MUSEUM
