Tourism Kamloops COVID-19 Event Attendance Policy November 1, 2021

To ensure attendees are protected from COVID-19, Tourism Kamloops will be operating enhanced safety measures to maximize protection for all attendees and participants during any events or meetings hosted by Tourism Kamloops on or offsite.

In addition to the below requirements, Tourism Kamloops will remain fully compliant with provincial and Interior Health regulations and guidelines to help prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Individual Restrictions to ensure the safety of our employees, stakeholders, contractors, and community at large:

• Attendees must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 (double vaccination) and will be required to provide proof of such vaccination history prior to entry.

• Face masks will be required to be worn throughout the event, except while eating and drinking. Face masks will be provided to guests who do not have one.

• Personal contact information for each attendee will be recorded to support contact tracing measures. Prior to entry, each attendee will provide confirmation that they do not have COVID-19 or have been in contact with someone who has COVID-19, and that they are in full compliance with the current municipal and provincial health guidelines.

Event Safety Protocol:

• The total number of attendees permitted to be in an indoor portion of the event space at any one time will be limited to the number that can maintain a physical distance of at least two metres from every other person and may not exceed capacity allowable the day of the event.

- Sanitizing stations will be located throughout the venue with appropriate signage to encourage regular sanitizing by attendees.
- Social distancing of at least six feet apart will be monitored throughout the event.
- Dining tables and other seating will be at least six feet apart in distance.

These restrictions and protocols are subject to change based on municipal and provincial regulations at the time of the event.

Anyone who is found to be in breach of these measures will be required to leave the event immediately.

Tourism Kamloops reserves the right to refuse entry to any individuals who cannot provide proof of double vaccination and to those who no not comply with the above safety protocols.
