Doing so allows our content to perform better for platform algorithms which leads to our content be seen by more people.

In addition, we are asking all Kansans and lovers of Kansas to join in the excitement by creating your own toast to what makes Kansas wonderful with a post using the 'To the ____...' structure.

Salute Format:

Choose your favorite Kansas location, person, or attribute, and place it in the "To The ___..." format. Then include an explanation of what Kansas means to you. Feel free to be creative. Include the hashtag #**ToTheStarsKS** in all of your posts.

Make your "To The" salute either a video or an image with text of what you're celebrating. Schedule or make your post for Kansas Day, January 29, 2023. (see examples on page #2)




