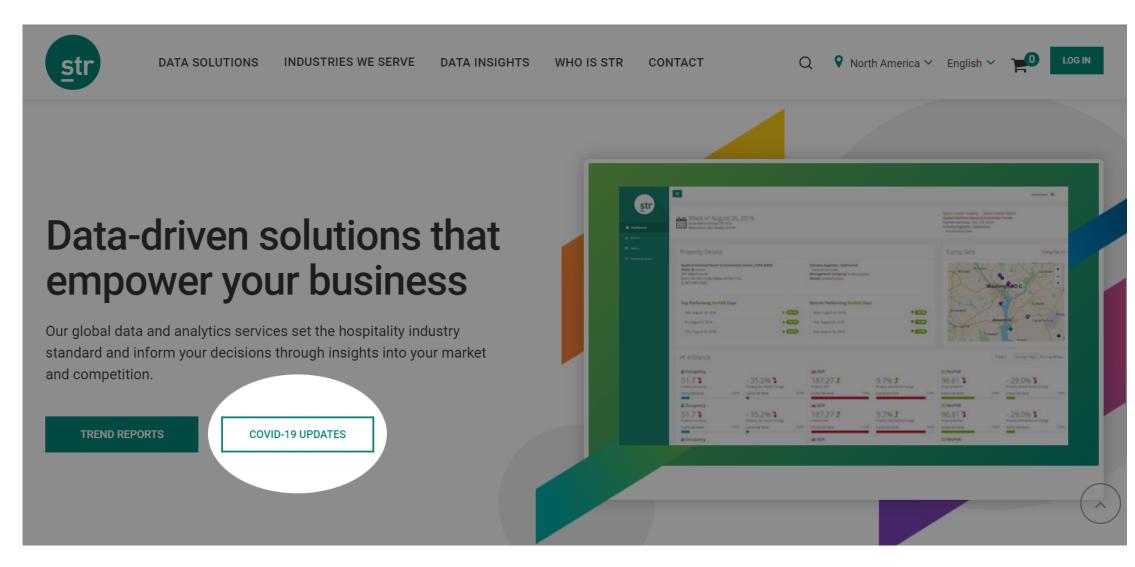

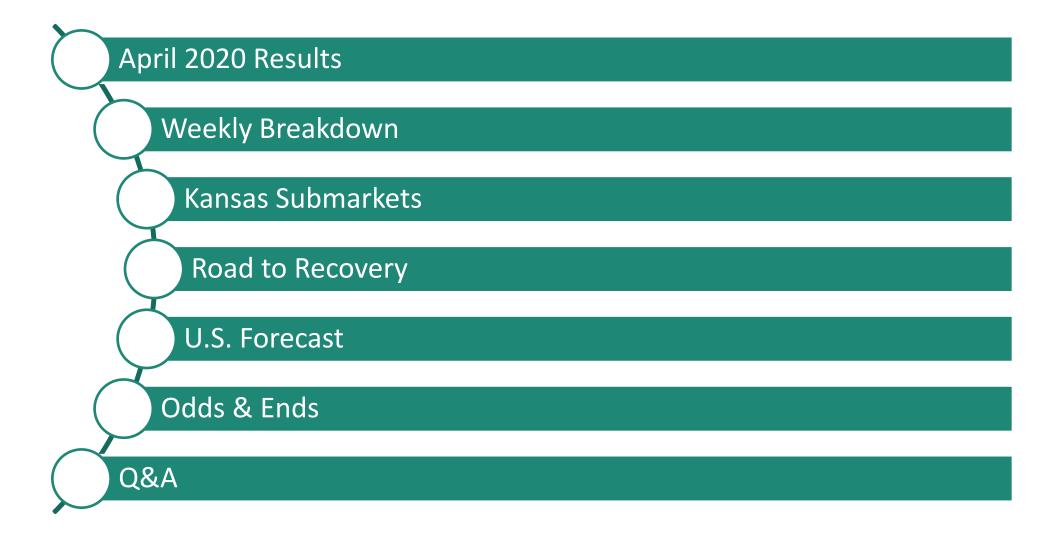

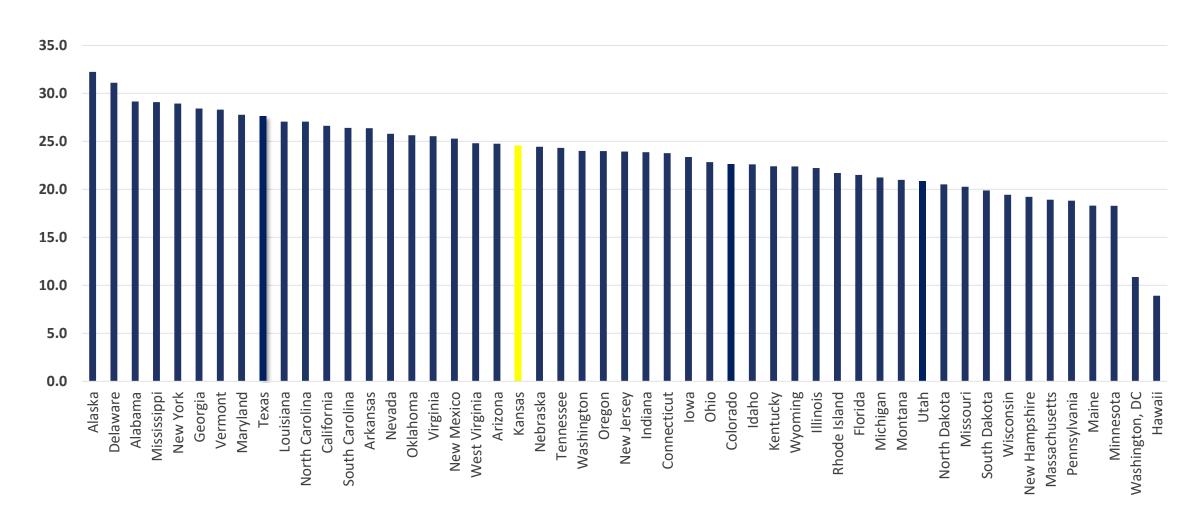

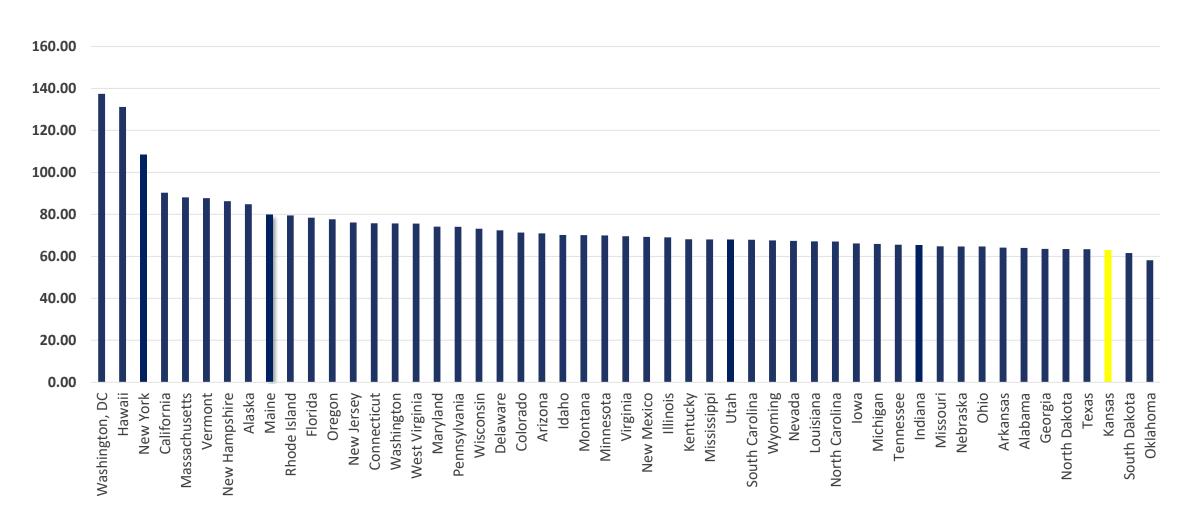
State Level Occupancy – KS Ranked #21





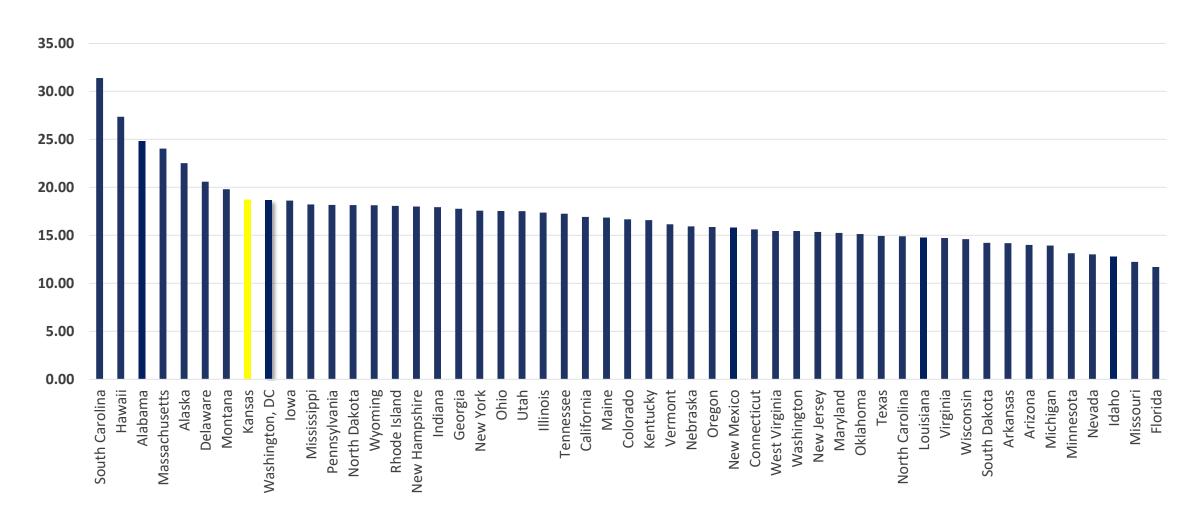
State Level ADR - KS Ranked #49

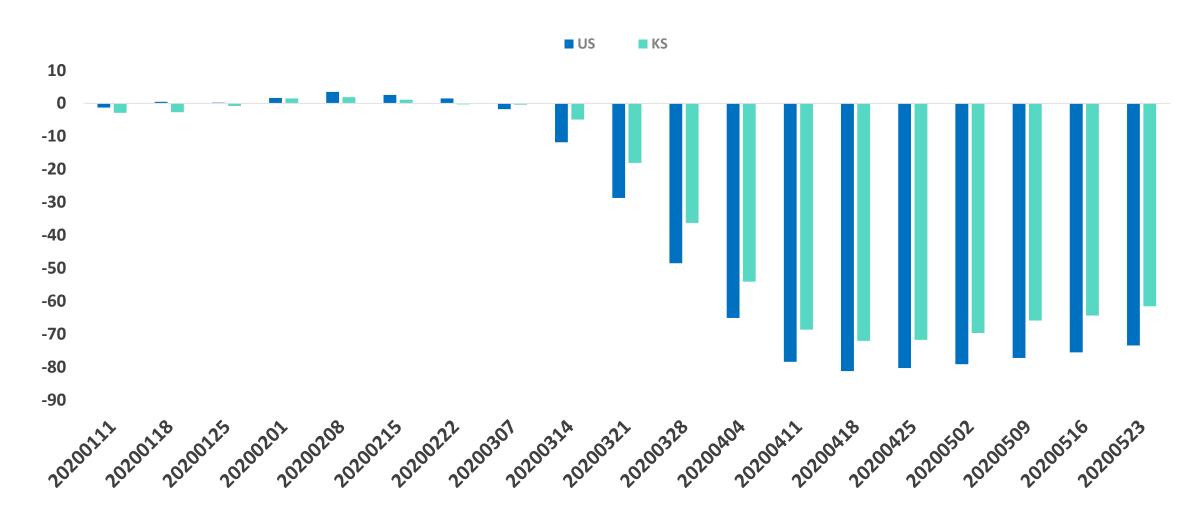

Total U.S. vs Kansas, 2020, by Week



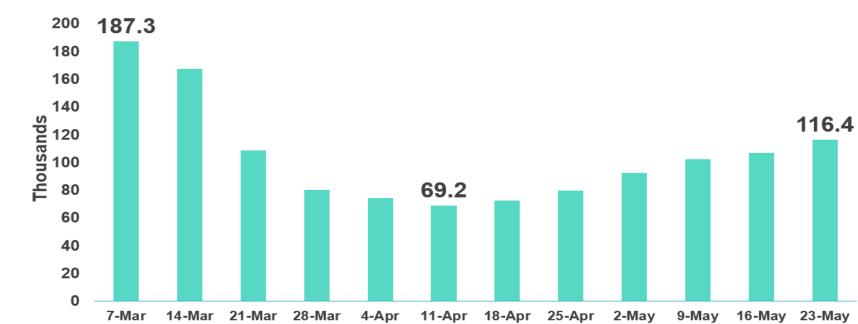
Weekly Room Demand – 5th Week of Increases

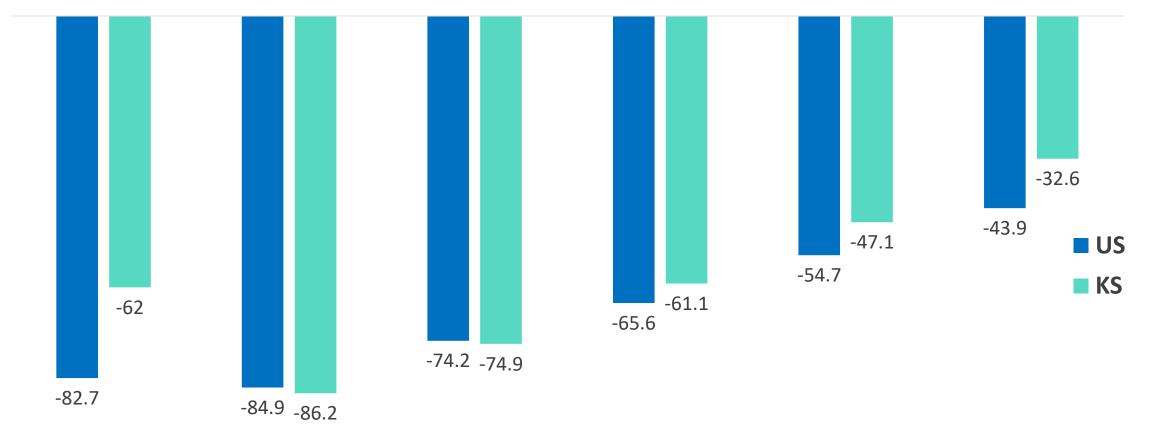

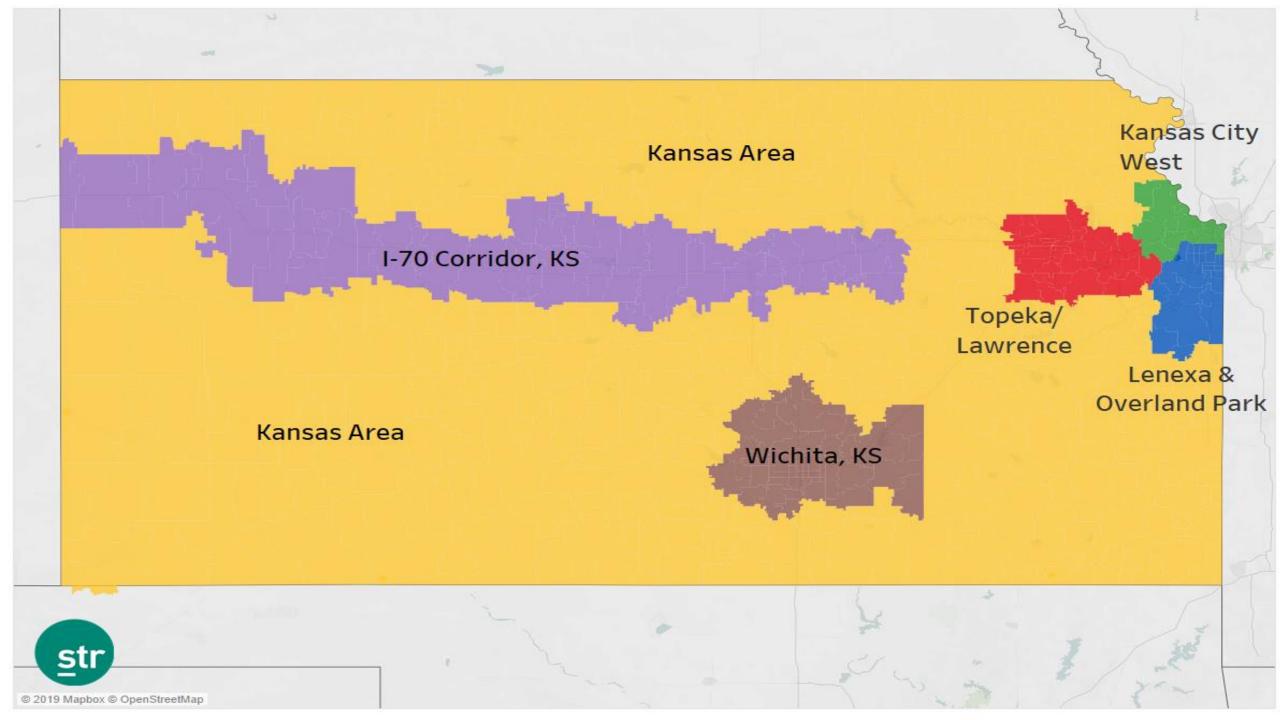

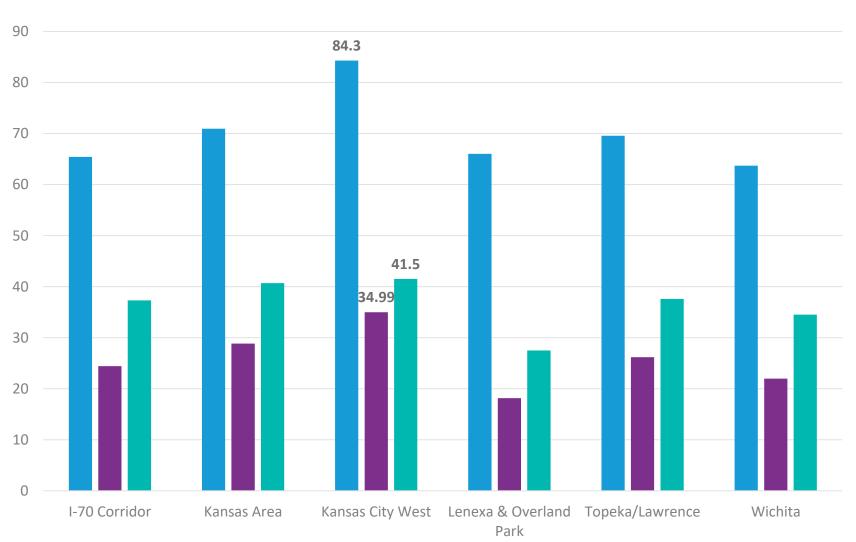

Kansas Submarket Performance – KC West Performs Slightly Better Week Ending 5/23

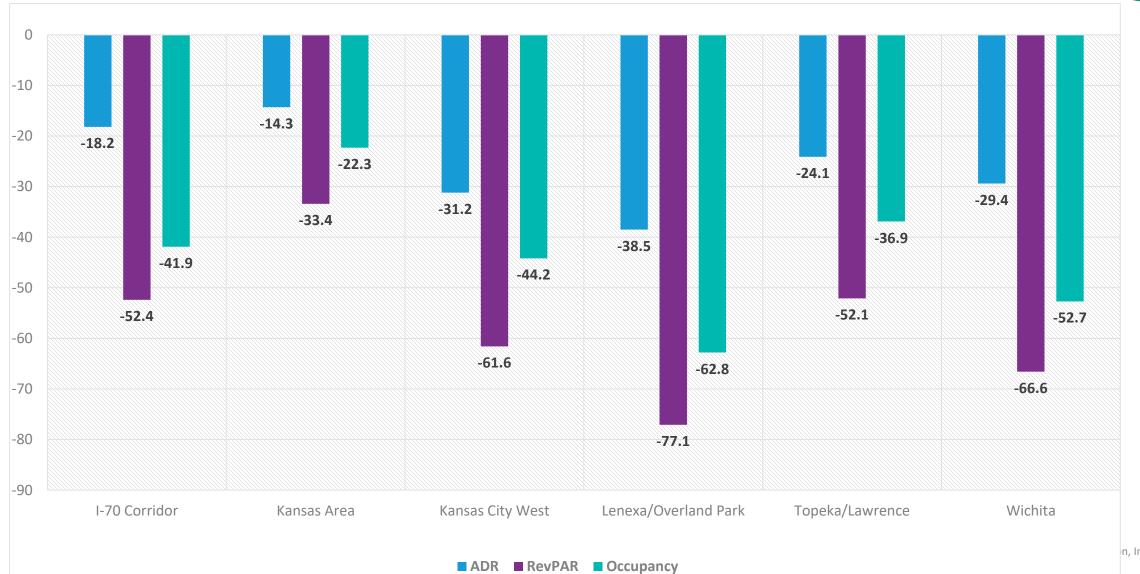

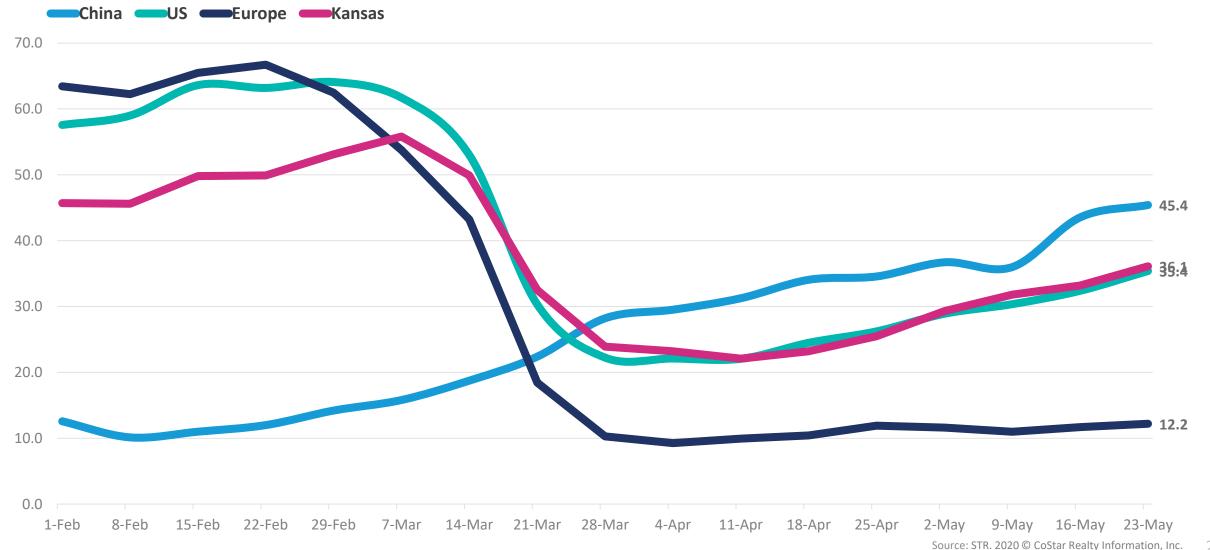
