Taqueria Tour

Take a taqueria tour in downtown Kansas City, KS to enjoy some of the finest authentic Mexican street tacos in the KC area. There are dozens of taquerias and Mexican restaurants around here, but five were recently recognized for their classic street food: Bonito Michoacan, El Camino Real, Tacos El Tio, Carneceria El Torito II, and Carneceria La Siete. Get ready to feast on al pastor tacos, fresh fried chips and homemade sauces. Some are also connected to grocery stores, so you can stock up on your own street taco fixings.

Smokin' BBQ

Gates Bar-B-Q and Arthur Bryant's are legends on the Kansas City barbecue scene. Kansas City, KS is fortunate to have both within its boundaries, along with a number of other barbecue restaurants that have made their mark. Among the many popular places making a name for themselves on the barbecue circuit are Joe's Kansas City Bar-B-Que, Slap's BBQ and Woodyard Bar-B-Que. Get your fill of ribs and burnt ends while trying to figure out which restaurant is your personal favorite.

The museum has a vast collection of Native American and fire department artifacts and more. The **Grinter Place State Historic Site** is a beautiful farmstead home overlooking the Kansas River. It honors Moses Grinter, who established the first ferry across the river. To get some insight about the ethnic heritage of the people who made Kansas City, KS what it is today, visit the **Strawberry Hill Museum**.






Explore History

Abolitionist John Brown and the Underground Railroad are at the heart of history in Kansas City, KS. To learn more about this time period and its impact on the area (and around the country), make a visit to the Quindaro area. The town of Quindaro, in what is now Kansas City, KS, was founded in 1856 as a port of entry for free soil immigrants into Kansas. It also became an important station on the Underground Railroad. Some of the sites to see include the **Old Quindaro Museum**, the **Quindaro Underground Railroad Museum** and **Quindaro Ruins Overlook**.

War Memorials

The people who have served this country are honored at several war memorials in Kansas City, KS. Two life-size bronze statues memorialize contributions of soldiers during the Korean and Vietnam wars at the Korean-Vietnam War Memorial. The Rosedale Memorial Arch, dedicated to the citizens of Rosedale, recognizes those who served in World War I. Located on the grounds of the Wyandotte County Historical Society and Museum, the World War II Bomber Builders Monument honors the men and women who built B-25 Mitchell Medium bombers in Kansas City, KS.







KC Metro Gems

The Kansas City area has a flair for the unique, and its museums are a good example of that. Kansas City is fortunate to have America's only museum dedicated to the Great War, the National World War I Museum at Liberty Memorial. Stand on the poppy bridge, view one of the largest collections of WWI artifacts, and go to the top of the Liberty Memorial for a one-of-a-kind view. The Museum at Prairiefire in Overland Park, KS brings world-class exhibitions of natural history and science to the Midwest through a unique collaboration with the American Museum of Natural History. To get a glimpse of what life was like on the American frontier in the mid-19th century, visit the Arabia Steamboat Museum. This exhibition showcases items recovered from a steamboat that sank in the Missouri River just west of Kansas City.





Focusing On Family
