- To understand the level of comfort by geographical area.
- To gauge the comfort level with Tourism Kelowna's advertising.

<u>Methodology</u>


- Distributed over Facebook Ads targeting residents of the Kelowna Census Metropolitan Area (CMA).
- The survey ran from June 3 to June 6, 2020.
- 616 responses were received.



Survey Results




1. Are you a resident of Kelowna or the Central Okanagan? 616 responses




Comfortable:	79.2% of residents

614 responses






Comfortable:	68.6% of residents

613 responses






General Comfort Score













Summary of resident comfort levels for welcoming visitors back to Kelowna





9. How likely are you take a trip in BC this spring/summer? 615 responses







Likely:	64.4% of residents

10. How likely are you to take a trip outside of BC this spring/summer? 616 responses






Likely:	19.7% of residents






Comfortable:	67.0% of residents
