What's New Kelowna?

Situated in the heart of British Columbia, Kelowna is the hub and largest city in the Okanagan Valley. OEB | Jan 2022

The Calgarian breakfast and brunch restaurant franchise opened its first Okanagan location in January, with a farm-to-table menu supporting local growers. The downtown location offers classics as well as trial menu creations including Deep-Fried Pierogies and the Korean Bulgogi Benny. | eatoeb.com

The Saskatchewan-based restaurant launched its second BC location in Kelowna this summer. From the group behind BNA Brewing Co. and Skinny Duke's Glorious Emporium comes a new and unique experience on Bernard Avenue. Located on the downtown waterfront, King Taps launched its first BC location this spring with a 500-person seating capacity and two floors of "270-degree lake views." The restaurant serves over 50 rotating taps, signature pizzas, and shareables. | kingstaps.com



AS BREWING SCENE GROWS, CENTRAL OKANAGAN BREWERY ASSOCIATION (COBRA) FORMS

The brewers of Kelowna have come together to collaborate on the growth of the local beer industry. The Central Okanagan Brewery Association spans six different areas of Kelowna with almost 20 locations to visit. The popularity of craft beers and the use of spelt grain to make pizza and baked goods has led to a rapid growth in Kelowna breweries that not only offer tastings and growlers, but meals and entertainment from live music to trivia evenings.

WINE GETS MORE EXPERIENTIAL

What started as innovative experiences to provide extra value to guests during the pandemic has turned into part of the wine culture in the Okanagan. Wineries now offer year-round experiences such as educational farm-to-glass tours, vertical tastings, snowshoeing through vineyards, and sipping wine in bubble domes.

KELOWNA'S PRESENCE AS A MOUNTAIN BIKING RETREAT IS GROWING

With a long cycling season due to its mild climate, Kelowna is quickly making its way up the lists for destination mountain biking where you can hit the trails, soak in incredible views, and end your day with a sip of award-winning wine or beer. The city recently hosted the first leg of the BC Bike Race, an Okanagan first, bringing top talent from across the nation to its rolling hills and mountainous terrain.

As Kelowna continues to grow, the message of sustainability is becoming synonymous with businesses and experiences. 


