

Kenosha Area: Destination: Shopping 2 Day Tour



ARRIVAL DAY 1

10 AM – If you're here on a Saturday, spend the morning shopping to your heart's content at **Kenosha Public Market** or **Kenosha HarborMarket**. The two farmers markets are open year-round on Saturdays - outdoors in the summer months.

1:00 PM – Enjoy lunch and custard at **Culver's Pleasant Prairie**.

2:00 PM – Shop for produce, baked goods, jams, dips, pickles, and more at the Country Store at **Jerry Smith Produce & Pumpkin Farm**, a third-generation locally owned family farm (seasonal).

3:30 PM – Take a step-on guide tour through **Kenosha's Four National Register Historic Districts** and also by these landmarks: Washington Park Velodrome, Franks Diner, the birthplace of Orson Welles, and the site of an Underground Railroad Station.

5 PM – Check into one of Kenosha's premier hotels for the evening.

6 PM – Enjoy "Casual Dining with a Twist" at **Twisted Cuisine**. The menu changes seasonally!

DAY 2

9 AM – Shop at the **Jockey Factory Store** in Downtown Kenosha which features your favorite innerwear, cozy sleep and loungewear, and a large selection of stylish active and casualwear. Since the dawn of the 19th century, Jockey International, Inc. has called Kenosha home.

10:00 AM – Continue shopping in Downtown Kenosha, including with a stop at **Sandy's Popper**, where you'll find fresh gourmet popcorn - and much more - to take with you.

11:00 AM – Shop at **Tenuta's Italian Market**, a Kenosha tradition since 1950. Enjoy this authentic Italian grocery in an "old world setting". Enjoy fresh cannoli!

12:15 PM – Enjoy a truly Wisconsin meal and Wisconsin souvenirs (say "cheese" - as in cheesehead hat) at **Brat Stop**.

2:00 PM – Enjoy more Wisconsin souvenirs, cheese, sausage and wine at **Mars Cheese Castle**. Founded in 1947, Mars Cheese Castle is a Wisconsin icon.

3:30 PM – Depart for home.

Additional Options:

Paint your own pottery at **Alpaca Art Pottery Painting**.

Take a guided painting class at **Pinot's Palette**.

Enjoy elite collegiate baseball and shop for souvenirs at a **Kenosha Kingfish game** (seasonal).

Shop for Kenosha souvenirs at a variety of stops, including the gift shops at **The Civil War Museum**, **Kenosha Public Museum**, **Dinosaur Discovery Museum**, and **Kenosha History Center**.
