- 10:00 AM Continue shopping in Downtown Kenosha, including with a stop at **Sandy's Popper**, where you'll find fresh gourmet popcorn and much more to take with you.
- 11:00 AM Shop at **Tenuta's Italian Market**, a Kenosha tradition since 1950. Enjoy this authentic Italian grocery in an "old world setting". Enjoy fresh cannoli!

- 12:15 PM Enjoy a truly Wisconsin meal and Wisconsin souvenirs (say "cheese" - as in cheesehead hat) at **Brat Stop**.
- 2:00 PM Enjoy more Wisconsin souvenirs, cheese, sausage and wine at **Mars Cheese Castle**. Founded in 1947, Mars Cheese Castle is a Wisconsin icon.
