

Kenosha Area: Destination: Shopping 2 Day Tour



ARRIVAL DAY 1

10 AM – If you're here on a Saturday, spend the morning shopping to your heart's content at **Kenosha Public Market** or **Kenosha HarborMarket**. The two farmers markets are open year-round on Saturdays - outdoors in the summer months.

12:30 PM – Enjoy lunch on the harbor at **Boat House Dockside Pub & Eatery**.

2:00 PM – Shop at **Tenuta's Delicatessen**, a Kenosha tradition since 1950. Enjoy this authentic Italian grocery in an "old world setting". Enjoy fresh cannoli!

3:30 PM – Take a step-on guide tour through **Kenosha's Four National Register Historic Districts** and also by these landmarks: Washington Park Velodrome, Franks Diner, the birthplace of Orson Welles, and the site of an Underground Railroad Station.

5 PM – Check into one of Kenosha's premier hotels for the evening.

6 PM – Enjoy the Wisconsin supper club experience on the Lake Michigan shore at **HobNob Restaurant & Cocktail Lounge**.

DAY 2

9 AM – Shop at the **Jockey Factory Store** in Downtown Kenosha which features your favorite innerwear, cozy loungewear, stylish activewear and much more. Since the dawn of the 19th century, Jockey International, Inc. has called Kenosha home. Jockey global headquarters continues to operate in Kenosha.

10:00 AM – Continue shopping in Downtown Kenosha, including with a stop at **Sandy's Popper**, where you'll find fresh gourmet popcorn - and much more - to take with you.

11:00 AM – Shop at **Pleasant Prairie Premium Outlets**. Ask the shopping center about group tour discounts.

1:00 PM – Enjoy a truly Wisconsin meal and Wisconsin souvenirs (say "cheese" - as in cheesehead hat) at **Brat Stop**.

2:30 PM – Enjoy more Wisconsin souvenirs, cheese, sausage and wine at **Mars Cheese Castle**. Founded in 1947, Mars Cheese Castle is a Wisconsin icon.

3:30 PM – Depart for home.

Additional Options:

Paint your own pottery at **Alpaca Art Pottery Painting** or take a guided painting class at **Pinot's Palette**.

Enjoy elite collegiate baseball and shop for souvenirs at a **Kenosha Kingfish game** (seasonal).

Shop for Kenosha souvenirs at a variety of stops, including the gift shops at the **Civil War Museum**, **Kenosha Public Museum**, **Dinosaur Discovery Museum**, and **Kenosha History Center**.
