The Kerry Ambassador Programme is a new county initiative, designed to drive economic growth through business events and raise Kerry's profile as a global business hub. It is led by Kerry Convention Bureau, in partnership with Kerry County Council, Failte Ireland, Kerry Tourism Industry Federation, Kerry SciTech and Prosper Kerry.

What is the Kerry Ambassador Programme? Céard é Clár Ambasadóra Chiarraí?

The Kerry Ambassador Programme has been created for community and industry leaders who are interested in supporting the county by influencing and attracting business events and investment opportunities to Kerry.

The programme was launched in October 2022 with an invited group of highly regarded individuals who are leaders in their field being formally inducted as founding Kerry Ambassadors.

They come from all corners of the Kingdom and the globe, across sectors as wide and varied as community, enterprise, academia, agriculture, business, engineering, medicine, science, sport, arts, culture, heritage, and technology.

The initiative provides a platform for our founding Ambassadors and programme partners to work together in pursuit of a common goal – to advocate for Kerry and to contribute to Kerry's ongoing economic growth and recovery, by placing Kerry on the national and international stage as a premier business events destination AND a place to do business.

What is the role of a Kerry Ambassador? Cén ról atá ag Ambasadóir Chiarraí?

To be an ambassador is to advocate for Kerry. Our ambassadors will use their knowledge, and where possible and appropriate, assist Kerry Convention Bureau and our industry partners in identifying new business events and or investment prospects for the County.

Ambassadors provide an invaluable style of advocacy, often able to fast-track access to event decision-makers and exert a level of influence in their field of expertise, personally 'talking up' the many virtues of Kerry to their colleagues and networks.

In showcasing the county as an industry leader in enterprise, innovation, and research, our ambassadors will serve to shine a light on Kerry's enterprise sector, communicating the vibrancy of the county's business ecosystem and academia.

Half of all conferences confirmed for Ireland each year are secured by an ambassador. By encouraging individuals and companies to consider Kerry as a place to hold events, do business, progress a career and a location of choice for investment, both private and public, our founding Ambassadors will play a significant role in promoting economic, social and community outcomes for Kerry.






















Catherine Carty BA M.Med.Sci
