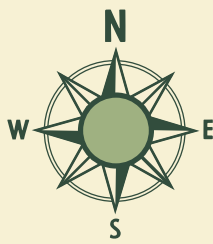

### 1 MANGANESE FALLS

47.4609, -87.8782

- Moderate
- Pets Allowed
- Down & Back

- From US Hwy. 41 in Copper Harbor, turn south at the Copper Harbor Visitor Center onto Lake Manganese Rd. and go approximately 0.7 miles.
- The falls are about 100 feet from the road on the left.

### 2 MONTREAL FALLS

47.3899, -87.8305

- Challenging
- Pets Allowed
- Down & Back

- From Copper Harbor, turn south at the Copper Harbor Visitor Center onto Manganese Rd. and go approximately 2 miles. Note: These are unpaved two-track roads. Expect rough conditions.
- Turn left onto Clark Mine Rd. and go approximately 2 miles.
- Clark Mine Rd. turns slightly right and becomes Burma Rd. Keep going for another 3.6 miles.
- Turn right on Mandan Rd. and go about 1 mile.
- Turn left following signs to Hoar Lake/Fish Cove. Road ends in a rustic parking lot.
- Follow foot path to Lake Superior shoreline.
- Lower Falls can be accessed from Fish Cove via a challenging one-mile hike west along the shoreline.
- Hike north along river 0.5 miles to reach Upper Falls.

### 3 SILVER RIVER FALLS

47.4628, -88.0724

- Easy
- Pets Allowed
- Down & Back

- 4.5 miles east of Eagle Harbor along State Hwy. M-26.
- A rustic parking area is located on the south side of the bridge spanning Silver River.
- A foot path to the falls is located on the north side of M-26.

### 4 HAVEN FALLS

47.3816, -88.0283

- Easy
- Pets Allowed
- Roadside

- From US Hwy. 41 just beyond Delaware, take Lac La Belle Road south approximately 4.5 miles.
- Take right fork at bottom of the hill.
- Continue 0.5 miles to Haven Park on the right.

### 5 JACOB'S FALLS

47.4280, -88.2373

- Easy
- Pets Allowed
- Roadside

- Three miles northeast of Eagle River on State Hwy. M-26.
- 40-foot drop.

### 6 EAGLE RIVER LOWER FALLS

47.4123, -88.2964

- Easy
- Pets Allowed
- Roadside

- At the bridge on State Hwy. M-26 in Eagle River.
- 60-foot drop.

### 7 EAGLE RIVER UPPER FALLS

47.4000, -88.2887

- Easy
- Pets Allowed
- Down & Back

- From US Hwy. 41 in Phoenix, take M-26 about 0.8 miles.
- Small roadside parking area on right.

### 8 CONGLOMERATE FALLS

47.3298, -88.4339

- Easy
- Pets Allowed
- Down & Back

- North of Calumet, turn left on Five Mile Point Rd. in Ahmeek.
- Drive 2.6 miles and turn left on South Farmer's Block Rd.
- Go straight one mile, then continue onto the two-track wooded road where the paved road makes a 90-degree right turn.
- Drive 0.4 miles to parking area near falls. Easement on private property—please drive slowly, stay on easement.

### 9 HUNGARIAN FALLS

47.1731, -88.4448

- Moderate
- Pets Allowed
- Down & Back

- From M-26, turn north on 6th St. in Tamarack City/Hubbell.
- Take a slight left onto Golf Course Rd.
- Go to the third trail road on the left and park along the road.
- Follow the trail heading west until you reach the Hungarian Falls area.
- Five waterfalls, with the highest one having a 75-foot drop.

### 10 REDRIDGE DAM

47.1496, -88.76587

- Moderate
- Pets Allowed
- Down & Back

- From State Hwy. M-26 in Houghton, take Houghton Canal Rd. approximately 4.8 miles to Redridge.
- Drive west 5.8 miles to the dam on the left.

### 11 WYANDOTTE FALLS

46.8905, -88.8775

- Moderate
- Pets Allowed
- Down & Back

- Drive 1.5 miles southwest of Twin Lakes State Park on State Hwy. M-26.
- Turn west onto Poyhonen Rd. to a parking area 0.8 miles on left.
- 250-yard walk along a rustic trail.

### 12 CANYON FALLS

46.6277, -88.4705

- Easy
- Pets Allowed
- Down & Back

- From Houghton, drive south on US Hwy. 41 approximately 42 miles.
- Canyon Falls Roadside Park (MDOT Parking) will be to the left. A short hike to the falls.
- Called the "Grand Canyon" of the UP. 30-foot drop.
