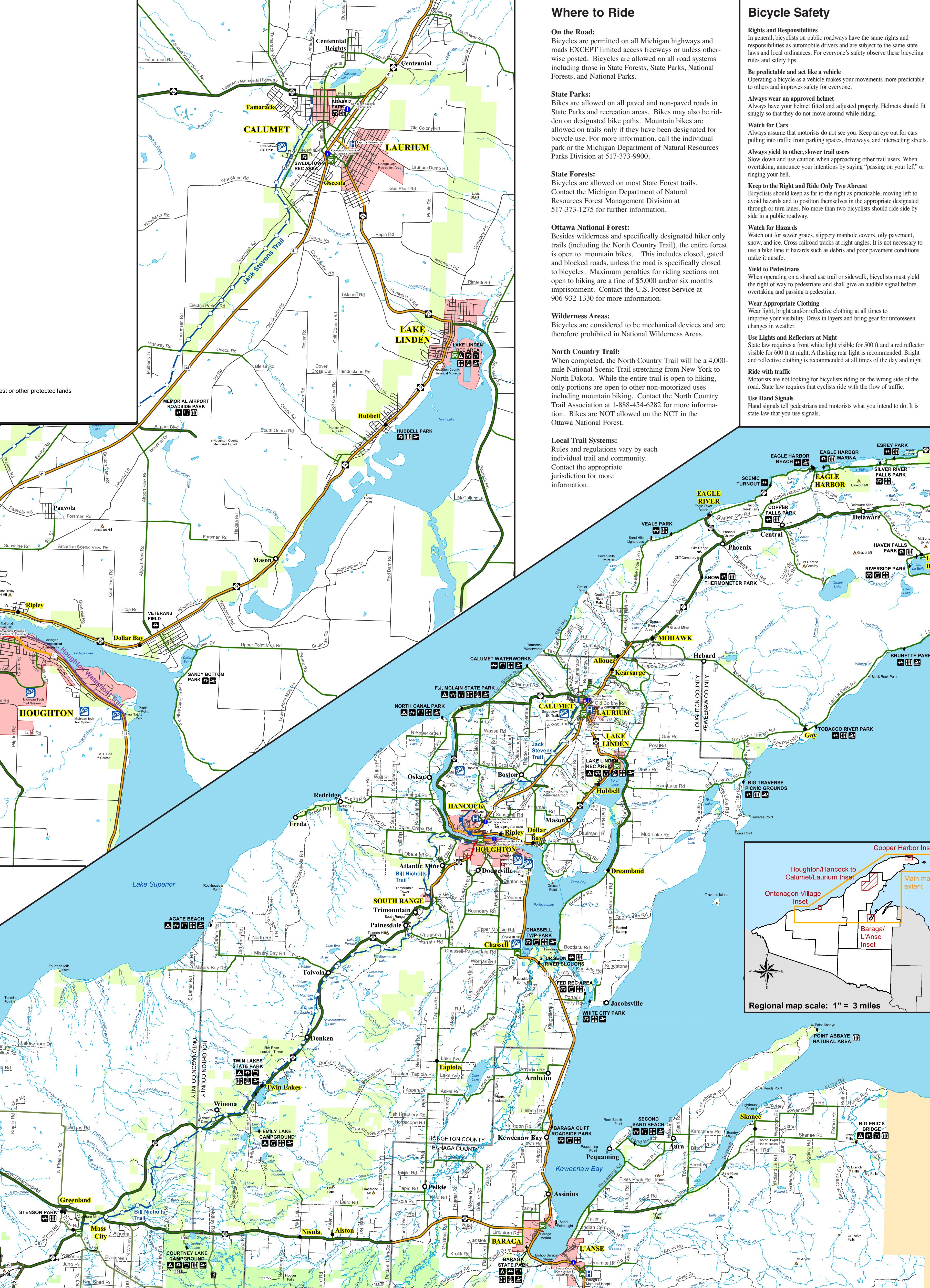

Use Hand Signals

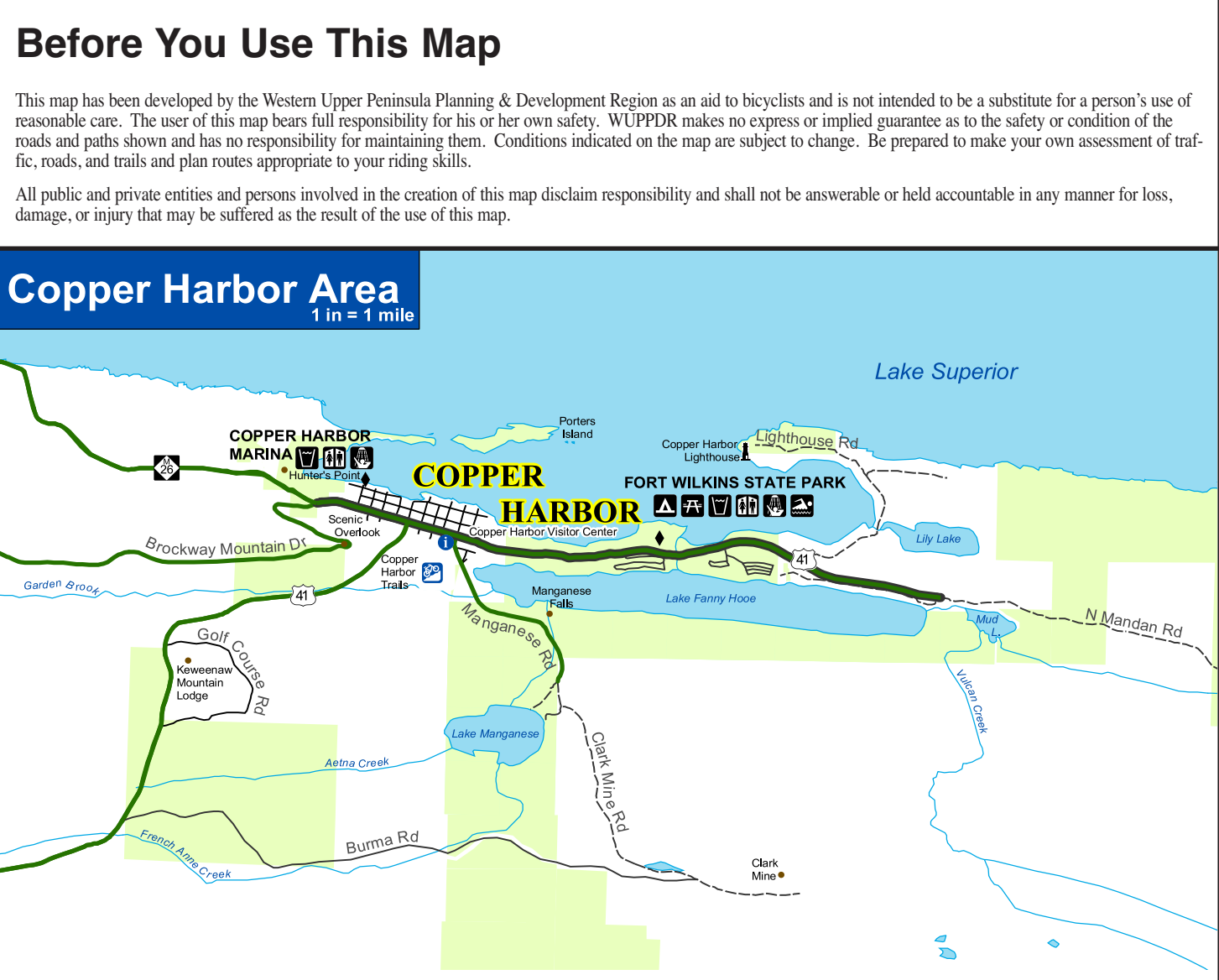
