Agenda Item Decisions

- Have all approvals and documents ready by the end of August to begin the candidate recruitment cycle on August 31, 2022.
- Better communicate goals with the employers
 - o The program does not exclude students who do not live in Knoxville.
 - o Create a pipeline to retain talent
- Ensure that language on the application is clear about the expectations
 - o Add "rising college juniors and seniors" to the flyer
- Provide a place for students to list possible scheduling conflicts/limitations on the application.
- Recruit one or two DBE companies to participate in the program.
- Actively seek to attract students of various ethnic groups
- Require periodic informal check-ins from/to employers
- Suggest a pay rate of no less than \$15 per hour
 - o Positions are competitive

- Students may interview with multiple employers
- Collect email addresses and send applications directly to students.
- Updated proposed program timeline:
 - o August 31, 2022 Announce the program
 - o Sept 15 Begin accepting applications
 - o Oct 31 Applications close
 - o Nov 1-18 Internship Program interviews
 - o Janu 1-15, 2023 Present candidates to employers
 - o Jan 15-Feb 15 Employer interviews
 - o Mar 1 Deadline for employers to submit offers
 - o May 1 August 12 Internships
 - o June July 2023 Plan for next year
