



One of the Ambassadors favorite stats is to help a visitor get where they need to be. However, these tasks are generally completed most frequently during events.


This includes but is not limited to helping others use parking meters, suggesting places to eat or shop, and answering questions about events, etc. Assisted 1,586 people over the last quarter.



Pie Graph


The pie graph depicts the percentage of Graffiti/Sticker/Bill Removal(s) each month.
