CHITIMACHA MUSEUM

Take a trip through the history of the Chitimacha Tribe, this region's first inhabitants, at this free museum. The Chitimacha ("People of the many waters") were known for their basket weaving artistry and the museum features artifacts and brief videos.

INTERNATIONAL PETROLEUM MUSEUM AND EXPOSITION

rig, the "Mr. Charlie," the centerpiece of a unique facility which also offers training for the offshore oil industry. On a guided tour, visitors will learn about the oil industry, the functions of the oil rig and hear tales of the industry's YPRESS BAYOU beginnings.

Try your luck at Louisiana's first landbased casino, located on the Chitimacha Indian Reservation in Charenton. GREVEMBERG HOUSE

Visit an authentically-restored 1851 Greek Revival style townhouse, which is on the National Register of Historic Places. Four "Temple of the Winds" Corinthian columns grace the home, containing fine antiques, PATTERSON documented wallpapers and early artifacts.
