- **1.** Evangeline Maid Bread was founded by the Huval family in Youngsville back in 1919 and moved to Lafayette in 1926.
- 2. Evangeline Maid's namesake comes from the title character from Henry Wadsworth Longfellow's epic poem "Evangeline: A Tale of Acadie."
- **3.** The founder's eldest daughter, Mary Huval modeled for the famous Evangeline Maid logo as you know it today.

- The original hand-twist process of making the Old Fashioned Loaf has not changed.
- **5.** The most iconic Evangeline Maid icon is the revolving bread sign outside of the facility that dates back to 1960.
- **6.** Evangeline Maid Bread supplies 50% of the state, which is about 30 percent of the state's population.
