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
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What's New!

This trail lets you sample over 50 of the area's iconic plate lunches that consist of meat, gravy-covered starch, a pair of vegetable sides, and a simple piece of bread.

Sample over 70 boiled crawfish restaurants serving up this seasonable crustacean or try the many variations like crawfish etouffee at Lafayette's local restaurants.

From chicken and sausage to seafood and everything in between, there's a gumbo for everyone in Lafayette, with over 30 restaurants serving up this culinary staple.

Buttery, toasted French bread stuffed with fried shrimp, crawfish, oysters, and catfish, the po'boy has many variations, including pulled pork, roast beef, fried chicken, and Vietnamese bánh mì.
