ITINERARY 1

ADVENTURE CALLS

- Begin downtown Sandusky with a morning cup of coffee, along with waffles, pancakes, eggs, and pastries at Vita Sandusky. Wake Up and Waffle offers creative waffle dishes and sharables along with a full line of morning cocktails to start your day off right.
- Once you're all fueled up, head over to Cedar Point Beach for an adrenaline boost at Northcoast Parasail. Sail high above Lake Erie on a parasail, cool off on a Jet Ski, or cruise Lake Erie on a charter boat. For a slower pace, rent a kayak or stand-up paddle board.



• Strap in for heart-racing, windwhooshing go-kart excitement at **Goofy Golf**. Put your putting skills to the test on the 18-hole mini golf course, try out the rock climbing wall, or test your gaming talents at the state-of-the-art arcade.



- Dockside Café is a great outdoor spot to catch a waterfront view of Lake Erie while enjoying gourmet burgers, fish tacos, fresh-cut fries, and a full bar. At Mr. Smith's Coffee House you can get a caffeine buzz along with wraps, sandwiches, paninis, and salads.
- Spend the afternoon exploring downtown Sandusky with a rental from Pedego Electric Bikes. Riding along the

Sandusky Bay Pathway is a safe and easy way to see Sandusky Bay and experience the fun of riding an e-bike.

- South Shore Pedicabs is a convenient way to get around downtown Sandusky. Use the pedicab as a taxi service or simply sit back and enjoy a relaxing tour of the area.
- When the sun goes down, embrace the game at Clubhouse No.3 SportSocial where you can experience



an array of sports simulators, table-top shuffleboard, darts, pin ball, and full bar service. **Archie's Pizza** will satisfy any hunger by serving up St. Louis-style pies.

 Release your inner Viking and hurl axes and enjoy tasty hard-to-find craft beers at Noble Axes & Crafts. Afterwards, grab some sushi and Asian-fusion dishes at Small City Taphouse and CLAG Brewing Company. Feeling fancy? Crush Wine Bar and J Bistro offer upscale, casual dishes in a non-pretentious environment.

 End the day with a sunset cruise or specialty winetasting or bourbon cruise on Goodtime Lake Erie Island Cruises on Sandusky Bay and Lake Erie.
