Rules and Regulations

Inspiration:

The theme “Frosty’s Magical Christmas” Frosty the Snowman is a snowman that was brought to life by the magic of an old top hat. He loves to dance, play and spread the magic of Christmas throughout our local communities with his jolly, happy soul! Help support the community as local groups and organizations craft a “Frosty’s Magical Christmas” themed floats for this year’s Electric Christmas Parade.

RULES & REGULATIONS 2019

Parade:

1. The parade will begin on Saturday, December 7th, 2019 promptly at 5:00 pm
2. Each entry will maintain a space of 15-25ft behind the entry in front of them at all times during the parade. Parade crowd & safety patrol will be located at regular points along the parade route to provide assistance and to maintain control.
3. NO entry is to STOP at ANY time during the parade.
4. Musical groups are encouraged to provide music for the entire length of the parade route for the enjoyment of spectators.
5. **FOR SAFETY REASONS, NOTHING IS ALLOWED TO BE THROWN TO SPECTATORS BY ANY PARADE PARTICIPANT, AT ANY TIME DURING THE PARADE. VIOLATION OF THIS RULE WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE REMOVAL FROM THE PARADE.**
6. All entries with animals **MUST** provide for clean-up of the staging area and along the entire parade route before, during, and after the parade.
7. Throughout the parade people cannot hang their legs off the sides of the float, trailers or vehicles. They must be sitting on something on the trailer and away from the edge.

Entries:

1. Each entry is required to conform this year’s theme (Frosty’s Magical Christmas) of the parade.
2. No entries will be allowed in the parade with a Mr. and/or Mrs. Santa Claus.
3. No float is to be higher than 16 Feet
4. No entries will be allowed that present a controversial message. The parade committee reserves the final decision on the determination of “controversial.”
5. Commercial entries must be crowd-pleasing.
6. Each entry is responsible for their own equipment.
