REAL FOOD, REAL LOCAL EUGENE

Taste the best dinners, drinks and desserts prepared by the area's most creative chefs.

Start the morning downtown at **Noisette Pastry Kitchen** (31). This boutique café serves up seasonal, local handmade sweets, savories and of course, coffee. If you're in town on a Tuesday or Saturday, the **Lane County Farmers Market** (32) is a great way to spend the morning. Find a wide variety of local foods throughout the year – including breakfast!

Enjoy the riverfront bike paths or a local hike to get your appetite ready for your next meal. Several craft breweries in town feature local ingredients in their food menus as well as their beer. Grab a bite and a brew at **Claim 52 Kitchen** (33), **Falling Sky Pour House & Delicatessen** (29), or **Viking Braggot Company Southtowne** (35).

Looking for a gift to send back home, or to enjoy yourself later? We suggest **Euphoria Chocolate Company** (26) and **Thinking Tree Spirits** (21).

When you are ready for dinner, there are plenty of options to indulge your palette. **Marché** (27) offers a luxurious farm-to-table experience, as does **rye Restaurant** (25), which also features house-made chocolates.

Party Bar/Party Downtown (30) is the perfect spot to end your day. Their organic menu features a fresh take on American cuisine, late night food, and craft cocktails.

The numbers adjacent to business names indicate their listing on the map.

TRAVEL TIPS

This year-round, self-guided South Willamette Valley Food Trail is designed to be explored at your own pace. We encourage you to inquire at individual businesses about seasonality and hours of operation before visiting.

High season varies per business but is typically **May – Oct.** Seasonality of key products listed below:

- Steelhead & Chinook Salmon: April – October
- Berries: June – September
- Lavender: Late June – August
- Apples & Cider: Late August – October
- Pumpkin Patches: September – late October
- Oregon Truffles: December – February

The working farms along this trail provide some of the most unique and engaging experiences. We ask that you respect the invitation to enter each property and be cautious around farm animals and equipment. Children must be supervised at all times and you should be prepared to follow all site-specific rules. For your safety and comfort, be prepared with appropriate footwear, sun protection and water.

WORLD-CLASS WINE EUGENE TO SOUTH WILLAMETTE VALLEY WINE COUNTRY

A weekend of award-winning wines as you make your way from downtown Eugene to the rolling foothills of the coastal range.

Start your day at **Provisions Market Hall** (28) in Eugene. Peruse specialty to-go foods and charcuterie to fill your picnic basket with tasty snacks. Make sure to ask for wine recommendations!

Leave the city and head west to Veneta and stop by **Our Daily Bread** (20) for a delicious meal or simply to grab breads and pastries for later. Another option is not much further north in Junction City, where you will find the **Camas Country Mill Bakery & Store** (9).

Then make your way to wine country and spend the day exploring the Prairie Mountain Wineries, five vineyards within a ten-mile radius. **Bennett Vineyards & Wine Company** (8), **Walnut Ridge Vineyard** (3), and **Brigadoon Wine Co.** (2) are just a few, and all have extraordinary views.

Want to completely unwind in wine country? Consider a relaxing night at **Territorial Farm Stay** (6) or take scenic River Road back into Eugene for the evening.

Spend your second day visiting tasting rooms south of the city. Start at **Saginaw Vineyard** (48) near Cottage Grove, and then climb back into the foothills for the famous pinots at **King Estate Winery and Restaurant** (46), **Sweet Cheeks Winery** (37), and **Silvan Ridge Winery** (38).

Finally, explore something a little different at **Alesong Brewing & Blending** (47), where craft beers are aged in wine and spirit barrels.



FAMILY-FRIENDLY FARMS VENETA TO JUNCTION CITY TO MCKENZIE RIVER

Explore the farms along the Willamette and McKenzie Rivers.

Start your day at either the **Spencer Creek Community Market** (36) or **Veneta Downtown Farmers Market** (19), where you can find bountiful produce and unique local vendors during their operating seasons. Head north past Fern Ridge Reservoir and visit **Bush's Fern View Farms** (12) for berries in the summer and apples in the fall.

Drive the scenic county roads to Junction City and explore the variety of farms in the area. **Hentze Family Farm** (4) is a certified Century farm with a farm stand, u-pick, and delicious cherry lemonade.

Continue south on River Road to find **Groundwork Organics** (10) farm stand, as well as **Thistledown Farm** (11) which has a farm stand and also seasonal activities including a corn maze and pumpkin patch.

Spend your next day exploring the McKenzie River, where lavender fields, hazelnut orchards and organic farms fill the lower part of the valley. Make a stop at **Herrick Farms** (14) and **Organic Redneck Growers** (16), who both offer an array of farm fresh produce and seasonal u-pick opportunities.

McKenzie River Lavender (15) hosts a festival in July that cannot be missed! Or end your trip getting acquainted with the river that sustains all of this with a rafting or fishing trip from **A. Helfrich Outfitter** (13).

The South Willamette Valley Food Trail is a self-guided journey through Oregon's agricultural heartland.

Enjoy farm-to-table restaurants, world-class wines and unique on-farm experiences along the trail.

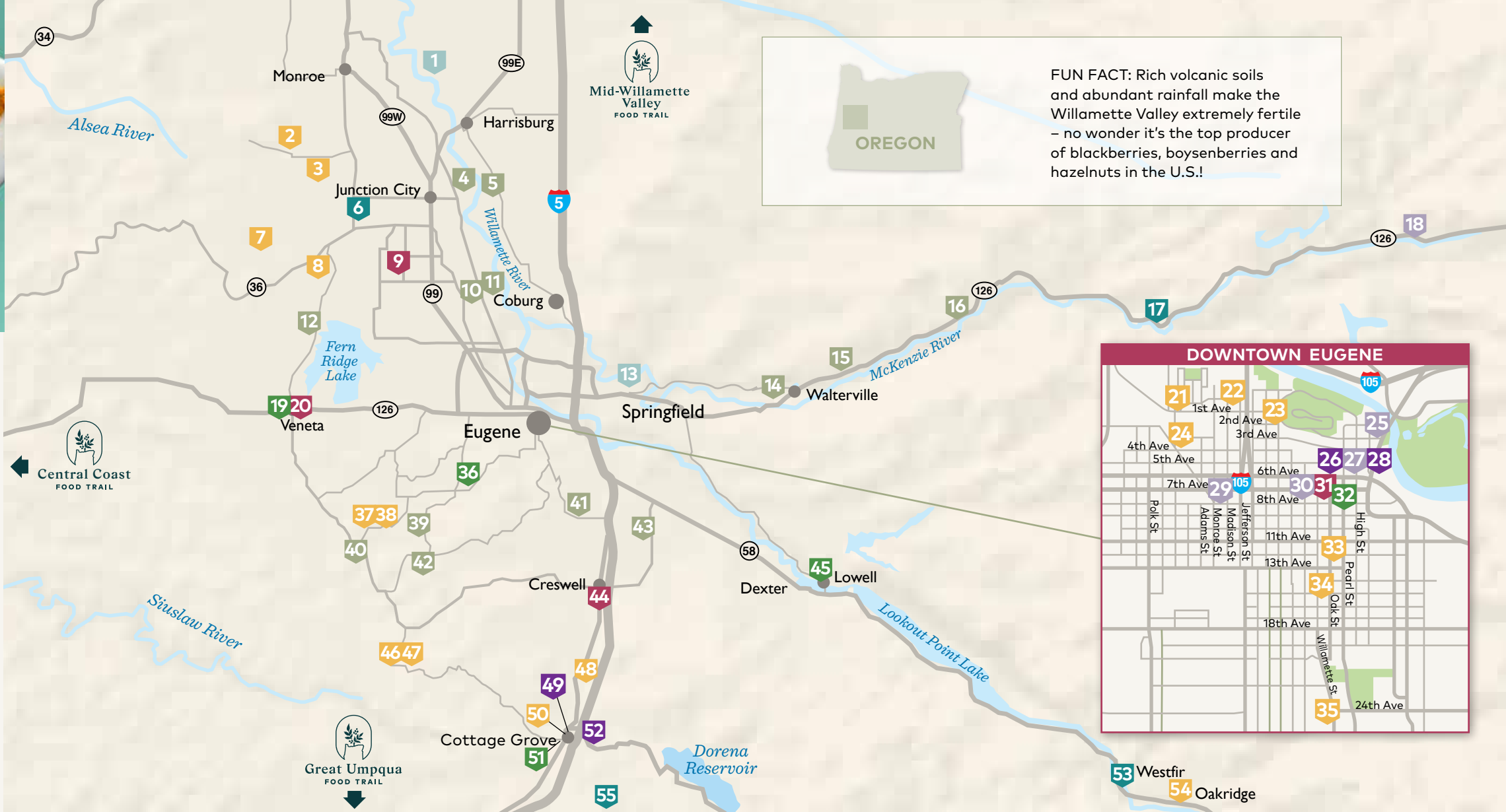
