RULES

- Turn the power OFF before transferring in or out
- Seatbelts or harnesses must be worn
- Ensure straps aren't hanging loose and that the knee bolster frame is down and secured with its pin
- No more than one person may use the Trackchair at a time
- Do not drive the Trackchair in more than 4 inches of water
- Do not operate the Trackchair under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol

TRAILS

- The use of trails at the Arboretum is at your own discretion and comfort
- Keep the Trackchair on trail
- We recommend the Improved Access Loop and Barrier Free Loop

TIPS

- Keep hands and fingers clear of moving parts to avoid injury
- There are five speeds, 1–5, which can be adjusted on the screen or with the joystick
- Battery charge is on the main screen
- When approaching inclines or declines, use caution, use a slower speed, and adjust your seat angle
- When climbing over small obstacles, approach the incline at an angle, not directly at 90° (perpendicular)
- Do not navigate the Trackchair on more than a 20° slope or else it may tip over
