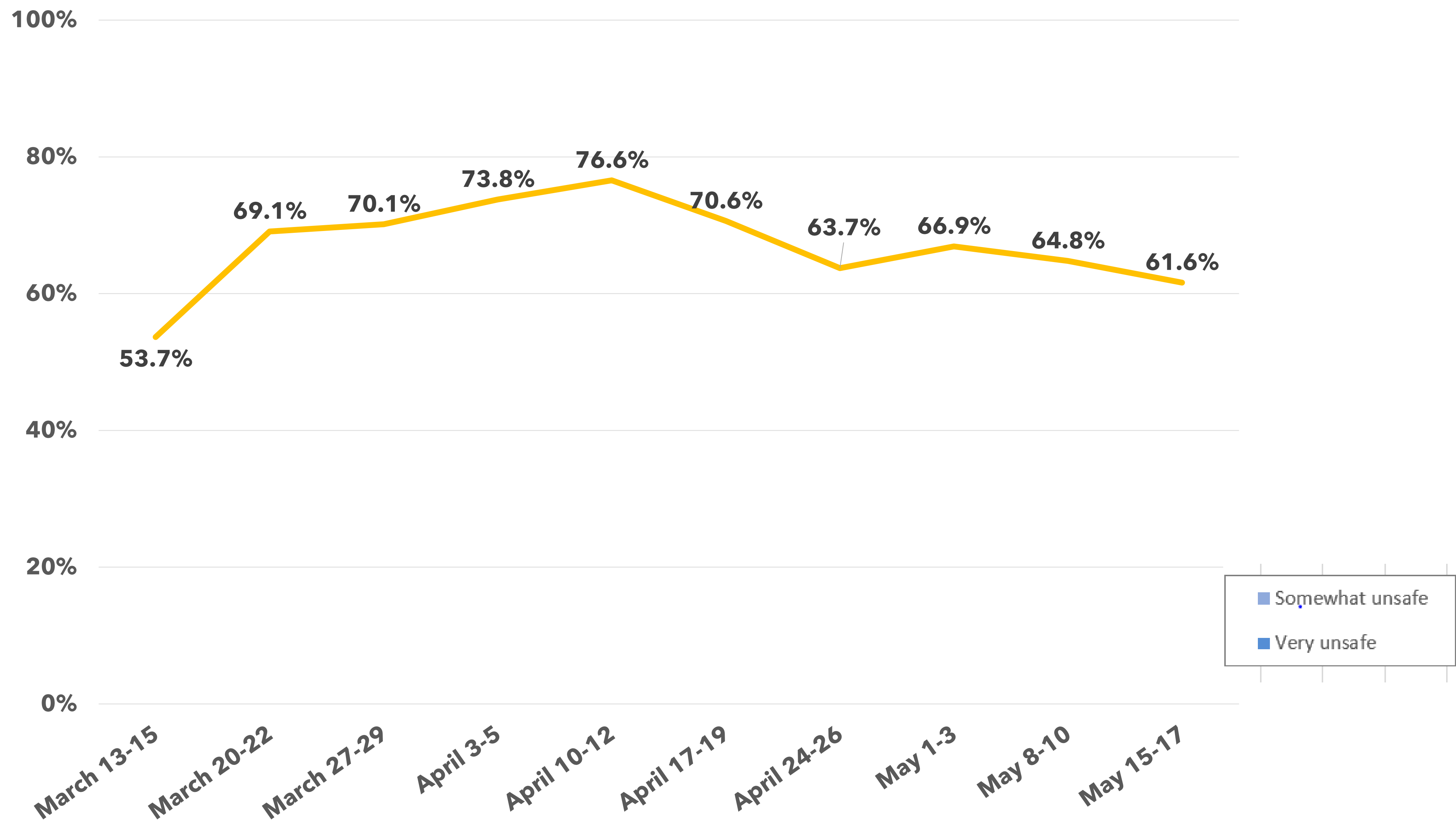

# Perceived Safety of Attending a Conference or Convention



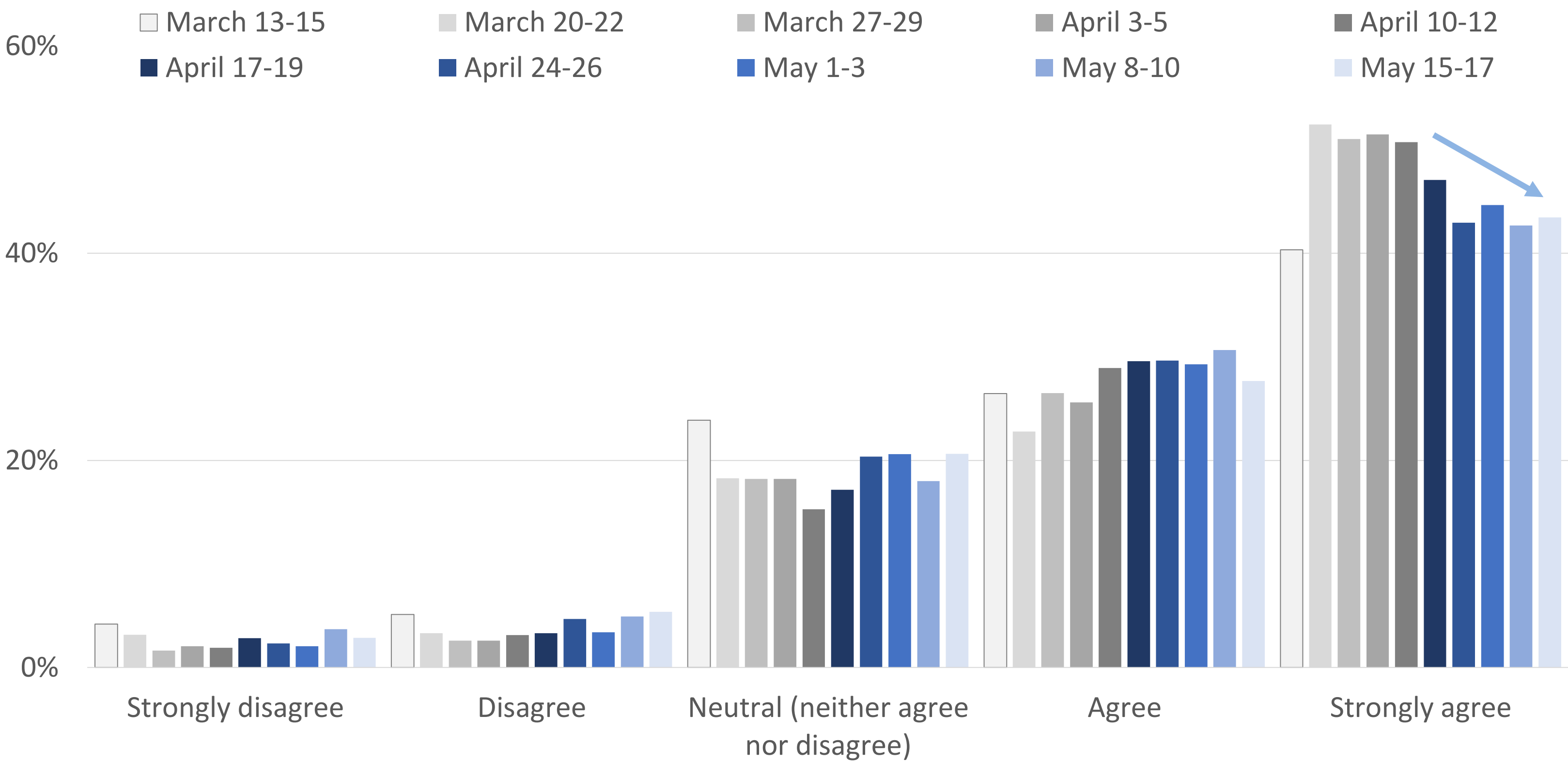

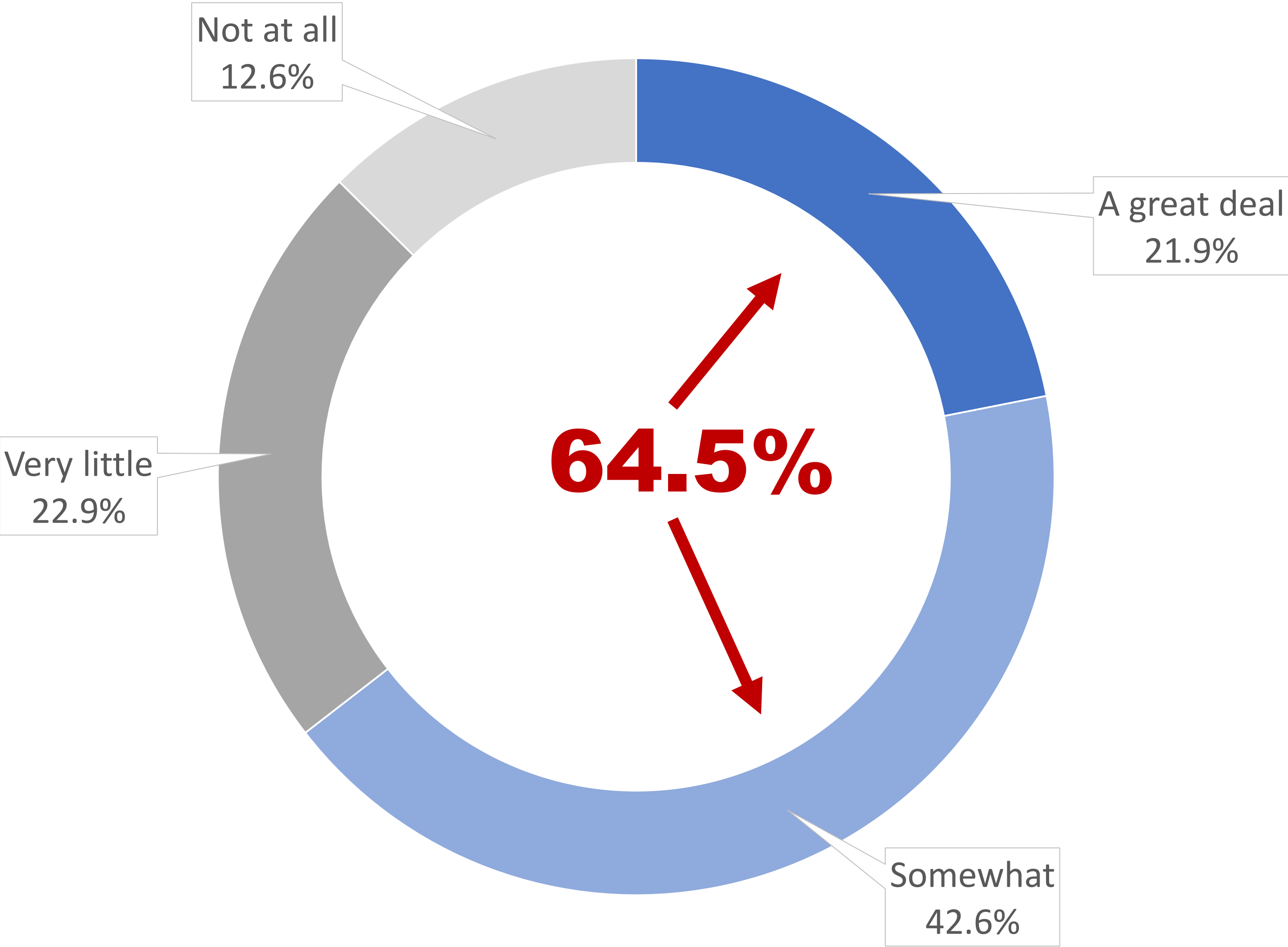
# Trust in Meeting Host Organizations

# Trust in Fellow Meeting Attendees

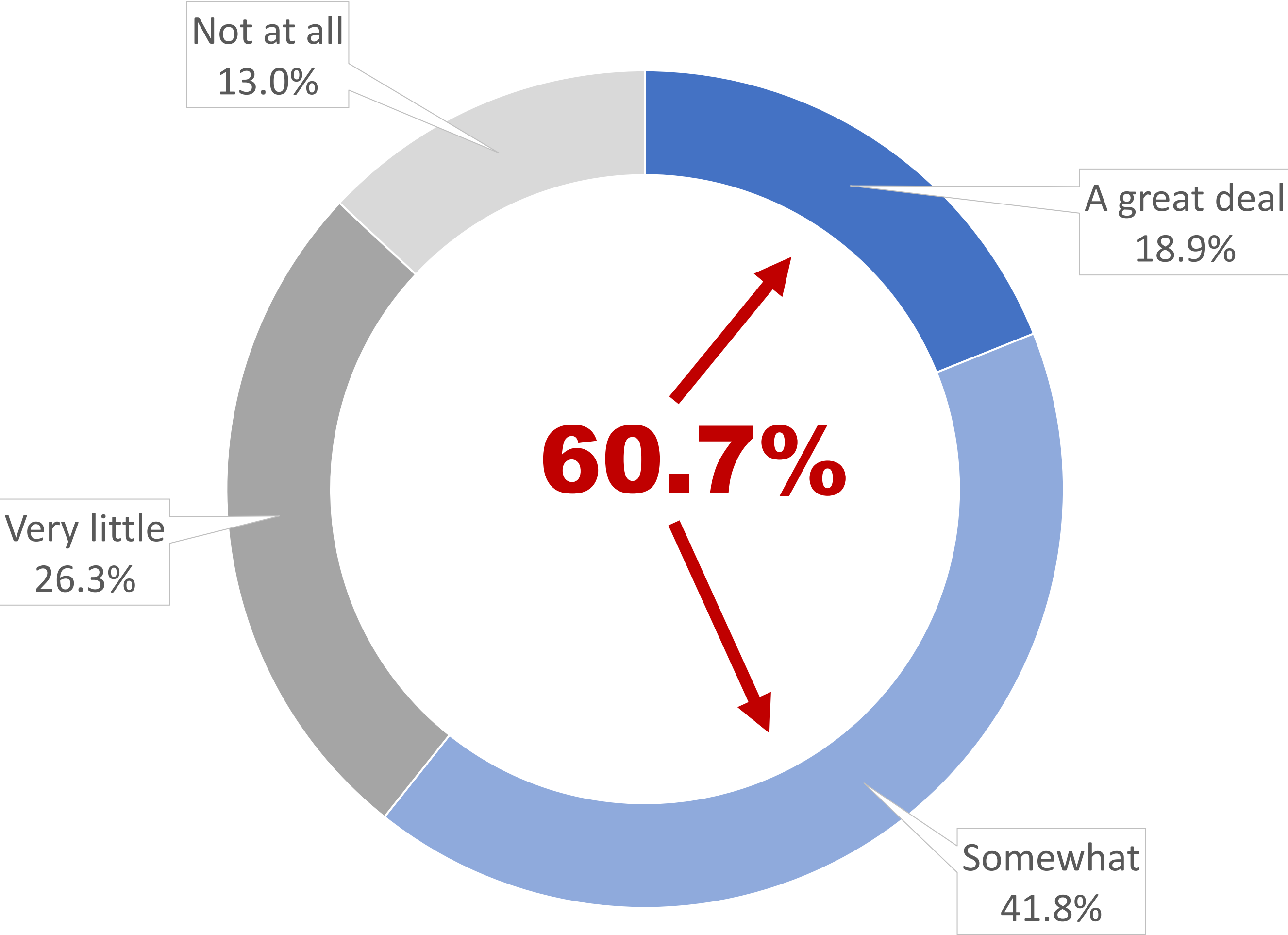
**Question:** Suppose you were to attend a conference or convention sometime in the next year.
