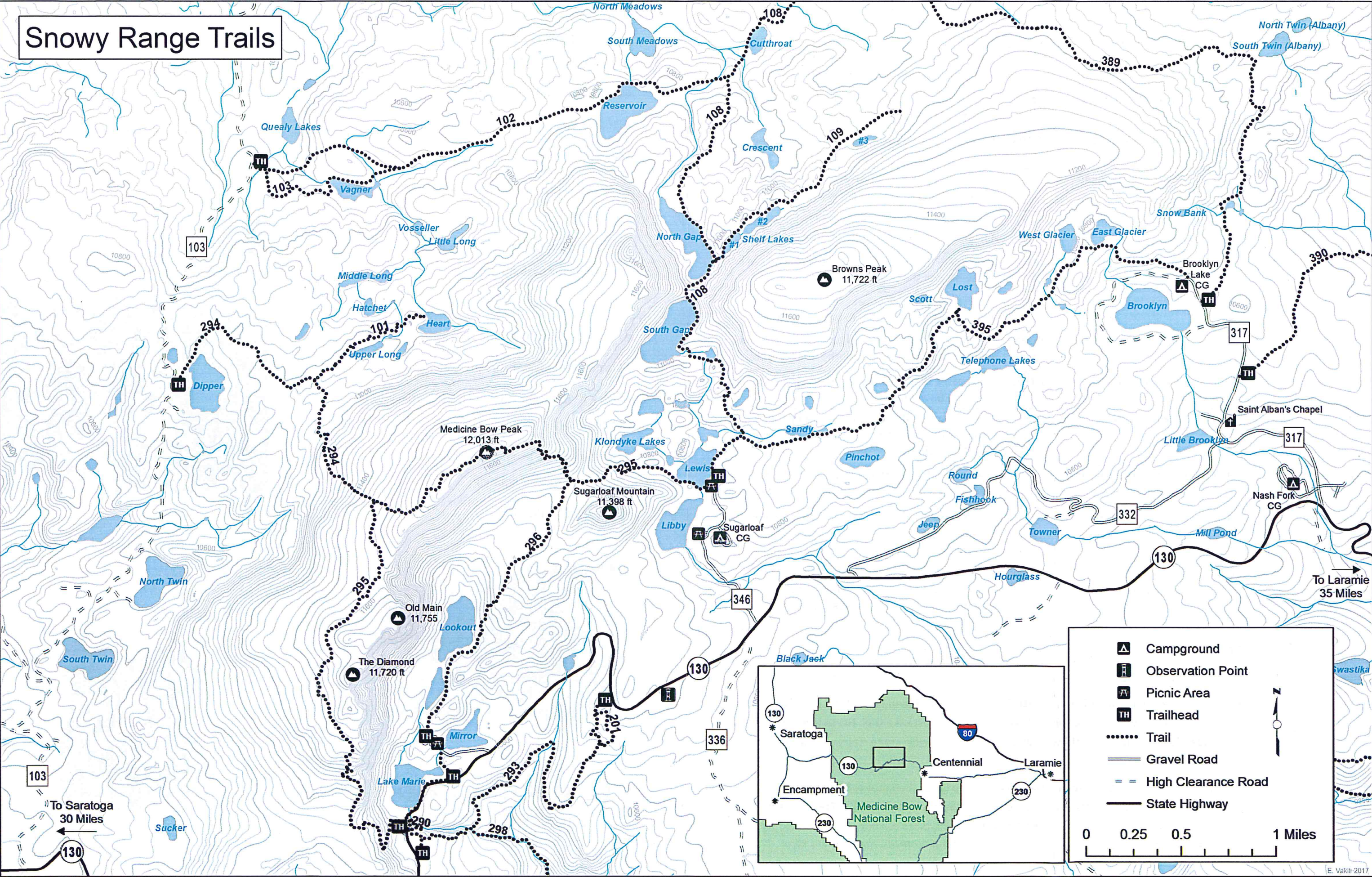


Snowy Range Trails



Trail Name & No.	Length in Miles	Change Elevation	Trailhead Location	Trail Info
Heart Lake Trail #101	0.8	200'	Dipper Lake on Forest Road #103	Access is from Dipper Lake Trail #294. Scenic alpine trail on west side of Medicine Bow Peak.
Quealy Lake #102		500'	Quealy lake on Forest Road #103	Crosses subalpine terrain north of Medicine Bow ridge passing three lakes. Very scenic.
Wagner Lake Trail #103	0.5	100'	Quealy lake on Forest Road #103	Spur from Quealy Lake Trail # 102 on Wagner Lake.
North Gap Lake #108	2.5	700'	Lewis Lake Trailhead	Follows a gentle grade past several high mountain lakes traveling across a few boulder fields.
Shell Lakes Trail #109	1.1	120'	Lewis Lake Trailhead	Access is from the North Gap Trail #108. Scenic alpine trail on the north side of Brown's Peak.
Lake Marie Falls #290	0.2	50'	Lake Marie-West Parking Area	Short scenic loop trail along South French Creek at the base of the peaks of the Snowy Range.
Silver Lake #291	1.6	280'	Silver Lake Trailhead	Loop trail around Silver Lake in subalpine terrain with a short steep section to get to the lake.
Tipple #283	2.1	400'	Tipple or Miners Cabin Trailhead	Trail traverses subalpine terrain with spectacular views of the Snowies and South French Creek.
Dipper Lake #294	3.4	1400'	Dipper Lake on Forest Road #103	Trail passes Dipper Lake and climbs steeply to Medicine Bow Peak.
Medicine Bow Peak #295	4.5	1600'	Lake Marie-West Parking Area	A very steep climb through open rocky alpine terrain with panoramic views. Trail climbs to the top of Medicine Bow Peak.
Lakes #296	1	900'	Mirror Lake Picnic Area	Goes through open alpine country past Lookout Lake with great views of Medicine Bow Peak.
Meadow Falls #297	2.7	350'	Silver Lake Trailhead	Loop trail which passes through subalpine terrain with a 600' spur to view Meadow Falls. Ties into the Silver Lake Trail.
French Creek Canyon #298	5.3	1600'	Tipple or Miners Cabin or French Creek Canyon Trailhead	#298 starts at milepost 0.6 of the Tipple trail from the Lake Marie trailhead or milepost 1.85 from the Miners Cabin trailhead for a total mileage of wither 5.9 or 7.1 miles.

THESE TRAILS ARE FOR NON-MOTORIZED USE ONLY

Horses: Horses can be accommodated in the North Fork, Deep Lake, Sheep Lake, Heart Lake, and Quealy Lake trails, as well as the Dipper Lake trail to the Heart Lake trail. Horse use is not recommended for the remainder of the trails due to boulder fields, stone stairways, narrow bridges, and user conflict.

Mountain Bikes: Mountain bikes are permitted on the North Fork, Deep Lake, Sheep Lake, Heart Lake, and Quealy Lake trails, as well as the Dipper Lake trail to Heart Lake trail and the French Creek Canyon trail from the Lake Marie trailhead only. Mountain bikes are not recommended on the remainder of the trails due to rocky steep terrain, boulder fields, and user conflicts.

SNOWY RANGE BACKCOUNTRY ADVICE

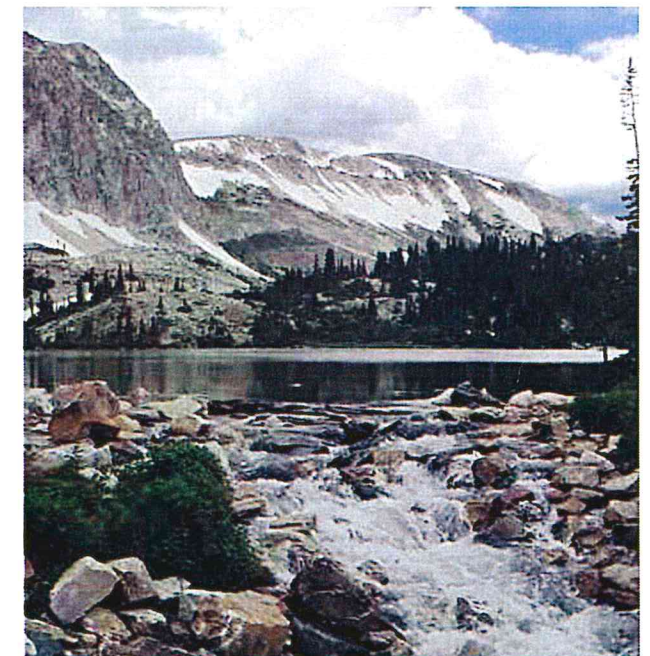
- ◆ Plan ahead and be prepared
- ◆ Hike in small groups
- ◆ Stay on the trail
- ◆ Select a campsite that is already impacted
- ◆ Be off peaks and passes in the afternoon to avoid storms and lightning
- ◆ Pack out all trash, including toilet paper
- ◆ Purify drinking water
- ◆ Camp 200ft away from any water source
- ◆ Use a lightweight stove instead of a campfire
- ◆ Hang food and keep a clean camp, especially in bear country
- ◆ Respect all wildlife
