FOR A SAFE & FUN EXPERIENCE

Hydrate before you go and take plenty of water.

Plan activities for cooler times of the day; avoid strenuous activity during extreme heat.

Don't go alone. If you do, tell someone where you are going and when you'll return.

Learn the trail, know your limits, and check the weather. Print or download maps as you may lose cell service.


Wear clothing that fully covers your body and protects you from the sun. Wear hiking shoes or boots to protect from surface heat and injury.


Use caution on unpaved roads. Roads may become impassable when wet. Do not cross washes that have water running. A high-clearance vehicle and full tank of gas are recommended.

Give all animals, domestic and wild, their space; watch for animals on rural roads.

Leave no trace! Take only photos, leave only footprints.




