

USE FIRE RESPONSIBLY.

If you choose to make a fire for cooking or telling ghost stories at night, do so only in dedicated areas. Pay attention to ranger warnings about fire risks during dry seasons. Keep a bucket of water nearby, and don't go to bed with a lit fire. One careless mistake could cause catastrophic damage.



Celebrate 250 years of WESTMORELAND HISTORY



Native Americans hunted and traveled through the area that is now Westmoreland County for centuries, making it the ancestral lands of Adena, Hopewell, Delaware, Monongahela, Osage, Shawnee, and Seneca-Cayuga. Early European settlers in this area were mostly Scots-Irish, German, and English.

Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, was officially formed by the Penn Proprietary government on February 26, 1773, and named after a county in northwestern England. It was the first county formed entirely west of the Allegheny Mountains and encompassed all of southwestern Pennsylvania, including present-day Westmoreland, Fayette, Washington, and Greene, as well as parts of Allegheny, Armstrong, and Indiana counties.

Community, industry, agriculture, and recreation all contributed to the various ways Westmoreland County transformed and changed throughout the past 250 years.

SPOTLIGHT: CONFLUENCE

he quaint neighborhood of Confluence, where Laurel Hill Creek and the Casselman River flow into the Youghiogheny River, floundered as countless industries left. "Let us consider what has happened," says Larry Walsh of the Confluence Tourism Association. "This town went through the boom and bust of timber, coal, and railroading. And now, it has been revived by bicycling."

It's true. The **Great Allegheny Passage** (GAP) – and its bikers – have revitalized the sleepy hamlet in ways that no one could have imagined. The GAP is a 150-mile bike trail from Pittsburgh to Cumberland, MD. Confluence is a level, 10-mile bike ride from Ohiopyle and 18 miles from Rockwood along the GAP. The influence of bicycles on the town is visible. Full bike racks outside the local eateries and guest houses are a testament to what the trail has brought back to Confluence – vibrancy.

A slew of new restaurants, accommodations, and even a bike repair and rental shop, the Confluence Cyclery, have popped up throughout town – all necessitated by the influx of bicycling tourism. Word of this cycling mecca is out, and Confluence is starting to gain national interest. Seattle transplants Suzanne Lentz and Pope Pankey fell in love with a shuttered car dealership on a visit to Confluence, which they've revamped into a cafe and artist residency called Tissue Farm. They have no regrets about leaving the big city behind for life along the bike path. "I even bought myself a fat-tire e-bike cruiser," says Pope.

Accommodations now abound in Confluence. Visitors can choose between traditional bed and breakfasts, guest houses, and two local campgrounds. Whether they are biking through town on their way to their next destination along the trail or arriving by car, there's a bed to suit every need. Mary Aukerman, who owns the Parker House, is often completely booked. She restored her family farmhouse to accommodate the new tourists. A stack of towels and bins for muddy biking shoes by the back door invites her guests to rest after a day on the trail.

While George Washington's guide, Christopher Gist, originally wanted to name the town Turkeyfoot due to the shape of the three converging waterways, Confluence is a better fit. This revitalized town is all about bringing people together.



while in town

RIVER'S EDGE CAFE offers sandwiches, salads, and burgers for lunch and a full dinner menu. Locals rave about the seafood selections. Enjoy your meal along the Youghiogheny River, and stay the night if you want – it's also a bed and breakfast

TISSUE FARM offers visitors high-quality espresso drinks and light breakfast fare. Their muffins and scones are made locally, and their beans are sourced from renowned Commonplace Coffee in Indiana. Pa.

THE OUTFLOW SOFT FREEZE has ice cream, as the name would imply. They also have pizza, burgers, salads, wraps, and more. Their Pittsburgh pork fries – topped with pulled pork, barbecue sauce, and coleslaw are a local favorite

THE CONFLUENCE CAFE has a broad range of lunch and dinner options, including vegan and vegetarian options. Just ask, and they'll provide you with a picnic basket and blanket to enjoy your meal on the levee overlooking the river.

MITCH'S FOOD AND FUEL is the perfect spot to fill up your tank, whether that be your car or your stomach. This quirky stop serves breakfast, lunch, and dinner seven days a week to locals and hungry visitors alike

LUCKY DOG CAFE offers creations like breakfast pizza and smoked pulled chicken quesadillas. They also have frequent live music and a fenced play area for children, making it the perfect hangout spot once you exit the trail for the day.





The menu at TreeTops Restaurant includes locally sourced items with a farm-to-table approach, quality imported seafood, as well as a rotating list of appetizers such as heirloom tomatoes in a whipped ricotta or red beet sandwiches with goat cheese. Designed to please, TreeTops Restaurant beautifully completes an architecturally-focused visit to Polymath Park.

Continuing the culinary journey though Laurel Highlands' Wright homes, Unesco World Heritage site Fallingwater and scenic Kentuck Knob also have unique dining options that enhance the architectural experience for visitors.

At Fallingwater, guests have a selection of enticing options. "From The Café at Fallingwater, to our Focus Tour option, to our highly localized forest-to-table events, we let the local ingredients of the Laurel Highlands be the inspiration for our menus," says Clinton Piper, senior administrator of special projects. The ever-changing selection of baked goods at the café is all baked on site, and sandwiches, salads, and snacks are available as well. Local sourcing is important to the team with food from His and Hers in nearby Farmington and Footprint Farms in Gibbon Glade, PA. Folks who opt for the Focus Tour take the experience one step farther by enjoying a private luncheon prepared by the on-site chef. The Forest-to-Table events are all about the food. The menus include trout caught from Bear Run - the creek that runs through Fallingwater. Foragers also bring ramps, morels, chicken-of-the-woods, and oyster mushrooms found on the property to the dinner table for these events.

The Hagan family, of Pennsylvania ice cream fame, was the original owner of Kentuck Knob. While they have since sold the business, the ice cream maintains the Hagan label in the southwestern Pennsylvania market. "For years, guests at Kentuck Knob have been enjoying a scoop or two of Hagan ice cream after their tours. It's the perfect treat on a warm, summer day, and it connects the guests to the history of




the house in a very special way," says manager Timothy Fischer. The Greenhouse Gift Shop also sells other Pennsylvania goods such as Red Ribbon Soda. For catered events, Kentuck Knob utilizes local favorites like The Stone House Inn. They've also started Food Truck Fridays, where a roundup of local trucks provides another on-site dining option.

From a quick sandwich in hand to a private treehouse meal, the options are impressive for dining at the Laurel Highlands' Wright sites.

Flight 93

NATIONAL MEMORIAL

A common field one day.
A field of honor forever.

Those words, etched on the glass overlook of the flight path at the Flight 93 National Memorial, greet guests as they enter the visitors center.

he 197-acre park where 40 innocent souls came to rest on Sept. 11, 2001, contains a museum of artifacts and interactive exhibits, a reflective walkway along the original debris field of the crash, and the Tower of Voices – a 93-foot-tall sculpture containing 40 wind-activated chimes in memory of the lives lost. While the entire park can be explored solo, the programs provided by National Park Service Rangers and volunteers add more depth to the experience. Kids can complete the Junior Ranger Program and receive a badge at their

swearing-in ceremony. The Story of Flight 93 presentation, given twice daily by the rangers, walks visitors moment-by-moment through that fateful day that changed this once-quiet field forever.

Hikers and casual walkers alike can enjoy a scenic and contemplative walk along the 2.2-mile loop trail around the Flight 93 Memorial. The trail features informative signage about the events leading up to the crash, wooded surroundings, plentiful native birds and the occasional deer sighting.

1 Insider Tip

Visitors to the memorial on a day without wind might not hear the chimes at the Tower of Voices. A webcam on the Friends of Flight 93 National Memorial website allows visitors to check back in on the chimes at any time.

s Fun Fact

Plant a Tree at Flight 93: Since 2012 137,000 native tree seedlings have been planted at the Memorial by more than 3,000 volunteers, including our GO LH staff. Saplings include a variety of native tree and shrub species across 197 acres at Flight 93 National Memorial. According to NPS, the plantings have accomplished the largest concentration of Restoration American Chestnut trees in North America.



MORE TO CONSIDER

While visiting the Flight 93 National Memorial, remember that the Laurel Highlands is also home to four other National Parks including:

The ALLEGHENY PORTAGE RAILROAD NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE

is a perfect stop for train lovers of all ages, where they can learn how the first trains were able to traverse the highlands. (1-hour drive time)

The FRIENDSHIP HILL NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE is a must-see for lovers of historical architecture. The restored colonial estate was once the home of Albert Gallatin, secretary of state for Presidents Jefferson and Madison. (2-hour drive time)



The FORT NECESSITY NATIONAL BATTLEFIELD features an interactive museum, a kid-sized fort playground, and a recreation of the historic fort. (1 hour, 20-minute drive time)

The JOHNSTOWN FLOOD NATIONAL MEMORIAL tells the tale of the wave that tore a city apart and pulled a nation together. (35-minute drive time)



SMALL TOWNS ON THE

Chris Rowan never envisioned owning a gory guest house in the mountains of rural Pennsylvania. The New Jersey-based art director and prop stylist has been a horror film aficionado since the age of 6, though, and couldn't pass up such a unique opportunity.

When he learned that the house that was the site of Buffalo Bill's murderous machinations in *The Silence of the Lambs* was for sale, he could not stop thinking about it. The 1910 home is situated along the banks of the Youghiogheny in Perryopolis. "The gears started turning...and turning...and turning. It became an obsession in less than 24 hours. It's literally all I was thinking about." Buffalo Bill, the serial killer who applied lotion to victims in his basement to turn them into human flesh suits, is one of the most infamous characters in the horror genre. Chris knew he could create a one-of-a-kind experience for visitors.

Two years later, the guest house is available for horror-movie lovers from across the world. Visitors can rent the entire house for a boutique lodging experience in a cinematic location. Not brave enough to spend the night? Two-hour tours are available when the house is vacant.

A new addition in the fall of 2022 added to the realistic ambiance. While the infamous well Buffalo Bill kept his victims in was originally located on a soundstage, they have recreated it in the basement of the home. Guests can even enter the well for their own "Put the lotion in the basket" photo opp.

In addition to four bedrooms that sleep eight total guests, this accommodation features a collection of 500 movies, a pool table, and 10 full-sized vintage arcade games in a den called Buffalo Bill's Playhouse. Conveniently located along the Great Allegheny Passage biking trail, a vintage train car is available for tours on the property, as well as more than two acres of gardens and lush riverfront property. LIGHTS, CAMERA, Action


For big and small screen lovers, there are several other terrific film locations in the Laurel Highlands.

The COVID-19-bubble Fall 2020 season of *ABC'S THE BACHELOR* was filmed almost entirely at the romantic and picturesque Nemacolin. (35-minute drive)

The Compass Inn, a museum in Laughlintown, was used as the setting for Netflix's *THE PALE BLUE EYE*. The film is scheduled to be released by 2023. (1-hour drive)

Ligonier gets a spotlight in the 2015 film *LOVE THE COOPERS*. The multigenerational Christmas movie was shot at various snowy locations around southwestern Pennsylvania, but the Ligonier Diamond provided the perfect setting for a magical winter scene. (1-hour drive)





LAUREL HIGHLANDS Bucket Lint

The scope of incredible experiences in the Laurel Highlands can be overwhelming - there is just so much to see and do! We've gathered a few of our favorites that shouldn't be missed.

1 | GREAT ALLEGHENY PASSAGE

This 150-mile motorless path, affectionately called "The GAP," traverses some of the most stunning scenery in the Laurel Highlands as it weaves along old rail trails between Pittsburgh and Cumberland, MD. Whether you want to do the entire trail or just a quick round-trip between two trail towns, the nearly level packed limestone trail is perfect for bikes, strollers, or even just a nice nature walk. The GAP draws in one million visitors per year – and it's on a lot of bucket lists, as well.

2 | THE WRIGHT SITES

Did you know that the Laurel Highlands is one of the best places in the world to experience the architecture of Frank Lloyd Wright, with four Wright homes located in close proximity to each other? Visitors can tour Fallingwater, Kentuck Knob, and Polymath Park's Mantyla and the Duncan House, plus two homes designed by Wright's apprentice Peter Berndtson in one trip. We recommend at least a two-day stay to fully enjoy each architectural masterpiece. Wright's Birdwing house will soon be joining the collection at Polymath Park, as it was saved from demolition and will be reassembled near the other four homes.

3 | FLIGHT 93 NATIONAL MEMORIAL

One of five national parks located within the Laurel Highlands, this memorial is a somber – and beautiful – tribute to the 40 lives lost on Sept. 11, 2001. Upon entering the park, stop at the Tower of Voices, where 40 wind chimes represent the victims lost. Head farther into the park to explore the visitors center, which has interactive exhibits and artifacts from the crash. The visitors center is situated just a short walk away, on the flight path above Memorial Plaza, which was constructed along the edge of the debris field.

4 | IDLEWILD AND SOAKZONE

This iconic amusement park has been delighting families since 1878, when it first opened as a picnic and recreation spot along the Ligonier Valley Railroad. The park is the longest-operating amusement park in Pennsylvania, and has been repeatedly named "Best Children's Park" by Amusement Today, and "Best Park for Families" by the National Amusement Park Historical Association. Young guests enjoy Storybook Forest, Jumpin' Jungle, Mr. Rogers' Neighborhood, and more. All ages enjoy the thrills of the park rides and SoakZone's pools, slides, water features, and cabana rentals.

5 | LAUREL CAVERNS

No one really knows how long humans have been exploring Pennsylvania's largest cave, but artifacts inside point to Native Americans exploring the vast underground labyrinth prior to 1776. David Cale has been the owner and custodian since 1986, when he purchased the property to reclaim this family treasure. His grandfather was the first to own the caverns, originally purchasing them in 1925. Open to the public seven days a week, the caverns are closed November through April to protect bats that hibernate in the caves through the winter. Surrounded by Forbes State Forest, the cavern can be explored in so many ways - ranging from a short, accessible guided tour to more challenging spelunking sessions deep within the belly of Laurel Caverns.





6 | COVERED BRIDGES

Pennsylvania is the covered bridge capital of the world, with nearly 200 bridges remaining in operation. The Laurel Highlands is home to 10 of these bridges – each with its own unique features and history. The bridges have had extensive work done over the years to render them safe and useable, but they were all constructed in the mid- to late-19th century. The Walter's Mill Bridge is believed to be the oldest bridge in the area, possibly constructed as early as 1830. The bridges are particularly lovely when traversed in the fall as the foliage peaks.



7 OHIOPYLE

Not only is this Pennsylvania's largest state park, it's also the name of a charming waterfront town by the same name. As the Youghiogheny crashes its way through the highlands, it creates prime opportunity for whitewater rafting, with calmer sections for paddle boarding or float trips. Several waterfalls amaze visitors along with Meadow Run, a natural waterslide. The GAP goes right through downtown Ohiopyle where an impressive bridge spans the river, making an ideal location for hiking and biking. Combine two bucket list items with one stop!

Laurel Highlands TROUT TRAIL


Any quiet shady pool, fallen log, or undercut embankment in the Laurel Highlands could be harboring a trout waiting to be caught. The Laurel Highlands actually contains more miles of trout streams than any other state except Alaska, and the Laurel Highlands Trout Trail outlines just how visiting anglers can find the fish. Our streams are loaded with native brook trout as well as rainbow and brown trout, which, thanks to conservation efforts, are now reproducing in the wild.

The anglers who manage the Laurel Highlands Trout Trail (LHtrouttrail.com) have spent years curating a list for locals and visitors alike. Stop by Loyalhanna Creek, which has been named one of Pennsylvania's Keystone Select Stocked Trout Waters. This lure-only area is great for seasoned fishers. On Pike Run, the Laurel Hill Trout Farm is a perfect stop for first-time anglers. The farm offers visitors free tours of their hatchery. They will even provide the rods and lures – no license required. Check out the map for more trout hot spots.




- 1 | YELLOW CREEK 40.56921 | -79.12655 Access via S. 6th St. Indiana to Metz Road to Ferrier Run Road. Best public access, state stocked, fishing is at this location where Ferrier Run meets Yellow Creek downstream to Rt 954 bridge. Stream above the lake and immediately below the dam is privately owned.
- **2 | LOYALHANNA CREEK** 40.24666 | -79.24632 This is the Delayed Harvest Artificial Lures Only (DHALO) and Keystone Select Stream section running downstream from the Rt. 711 bridge in Ligonier to Two-Mile Run Road (SR 2045). This 1.5 mile section is a large riffles and runs stream.
- 3 | CLEAR SHADE CREEK 40.14800 | -78.78400 Located off State Route 160 on the Windber Area Authority access road with limited parking near downstream portion of Fly Fishing Only Project. Vehicle access from opening day of trout until July. Walk-in access only after that. Clear Shade Creek is home to a stocked one-mile long Catch-and-Release Fly Fishing Only Project in a remote setting. The upper stream section, located in the Clear Shade Wild Area, is not stocked and harbors both wild brook and brown trout
- 4 | INDIAN CREEK 40.08911 / -79.33578 Upstream from this location along Rt. 381 to Hunters Lane is the Delayed Harvest Artificial Lures Only (DHALO) section. It is brushy with a combination of riffles and pools. Downstream is open stocked water for several miles with multiple access points from side roads off Rt. 381/711.
- 5 | STONEYCREEK RIVER 40.02710 | -78.92053 This is the Glessner Covered Bridge access point. The Stonycreek's classic freestone trout water of the upper gorge from Shanksville downstream to Stoystown offers stocked trout fishing in challenging terrain with limited access. The river is also stocked with fingerling trout and is a successful put and grow fishery. Access is from SR 1007, south of Rt. 30.
- 6 | LAUREL HILL CREEK 40.00860 | -79.23249 This is the Delayed Harvest Artificial Lures Only (DHALO) and Keystone Select Stream section upstream 1.5 miles to Jimtown Road (T364). Stream is heavily covered with old growth hemlock forest and is combination of riffles, runs, and pools.
- 7 | DUNBAR CREEK 39.94554 | -79.58082 Appealing mountain freestone with 4.4 miles Fly-Fishing-Only, Catch-and-Release section on State Game Land 51, from stone quarry on Dunbar-Ohiopyle Road upstream to Glade Run confluence. Access via Dunbar-Ohiopyle Road (SR 1055) and the gravel Betty Knocks Road. Walk-in fishing beyond. Downstream of stone quarry is general regulation.
- 8 | YOUGHIOGHENY RIVER 39.82656 / -79.37858 Middle section from Ramcat Access (Fayette County shore) downriver to Ohiopyle. Nine miles of big river through Youghiogheny Gorge and Ohiopyle State Park, accessible by Great Allegheny Passage Trail or raft/kayak. Class I-III rapids with deep pools. All Tackle Trophy Trout regulation. From Youghiogheny Dam outflow at Confluence, downstream two miles to Ramcat Access is stocked general regulation, with gentler gradient.
- 9 | MEADOW RUN 39.85405 | -79.49749 Excellent public access on Ohiopyle State Park. Lower 2.2 miles below Dinner Bell Road to mouth at Youghiogheny River is Delayed Harvest Artificial Lures Only (DHALO), Keystone Select. Much of this stretch is walk-in with falls, riffles, and pools. From Dinner Bell Road upstream 1.5 miles to park boundary is general regulation stocked water with access via Meadow Run Road (TR 798).
- 10 | WHITES CREEK 39.75516 | -79.31404 Eight miles of general regulation stocked water—pools, holes, and riffles, accessible at mid-point of stocked span via Rte. 523 (Listonburg Road) at Listonburg. Whites Creek Road parallels the stream east (upstream) of Listonburg.

Trout Trail Map



While licensed anglers in Pennsylvania can keep trout that meet legal requirements for size, we encourage you to practice catch-and-release so that everyone can enjoy our trout trail for generations to come. Use barb-free hooks, only handle trout with wet hands, and return them to their stream as quickly as possible.



he Laurel Highlands is home to one of the most iconic waterfalls in America -Fallingwater, where an architectural marvel is cantilevered over a tumbling creek. With such a showstopper in the region, it can be easy to miss just how many other gorgeous rapids exist in the region. The mountainous terrain, formed by North America colliding with North Africa during the Paleozoic period, provides the perfect combination of elevation and rock formations to create cascades throughout the highlands. Check out some fan favorites, or stumble onto others while exploring on your own.


- **CUCUMBER FALLS** Time and time again, this waterfall is lauded as the best in the state of Pennsylvania. Located within Ohiopyle State Park, the beautiful 30-foot veil waterfall is particularly scenic in the winter when smaller frozen rivulets create a sparkling tableau. The falls are just a short walk from the parking lot, with stairs leading to the top and the bottom of the cascade.
- OHIOPYLE FALLS This 20-foot vertical drop is perfectly situated to catch the morning sunrise in the east, causing Ohiopyle Falls to be a popular spot for a morning kayak excursion or bike ride along the Great Allegheny Passage. As the falls tumble into the Youghiogheny River, the roar is both deafening and impressive. Lucky visitors might even get to see some kayakers descend the falls. Leave that trick to the professionals, please.


- 3 JONES MILL RUN DAM One fact that sets this waterfall apart from the others in the Laurel Highlands is the fact that it is manmade. Specifically, this cascading dam was built within Laurel Hill State Park by the Civilian Conservation Corp known as the CCC Boys during the Great Depression. Completed in 1935, the trail to access the falls is flat and easy, and the wading at the base of the falls is perfect for even the tiniest hikers.
- 4 COLE RUN FALLS While this waterfall is far from the tallest in the region, it is stunning and unique in all seasons. The run of the falls makes a 90-degree turn as Cole Run rushes through Forbes State Forest. In the spring, high water levels make for prime viewing of Cole Run Falls but, in the autumn, the dense foliage along the waterfall is a true showstopper.
- ADAM FALLS A two-mile loop trail leads visitors to this lesser-known waterfall.

 Viewing is best from the top of the falls, as the terrain at the base is best suited for only the most experienced hikers. Located within Linn Run State Park, the trail makes these falls less accessible than some of the others. For those who can traverse the terrain, it's worth it to seek out this secluded spot for a quiet moment of reflection.



While at Cole Run Falls, make a quick stop at the BARRONVALE COVERED BRIDGE. It's the longest covered bridge in Somerset County as well as one of the longest in the state.







MILE 114.1 | WEST NEWTON

Perched on the banks of the Youghiogheny River, West Newton is a picturesque town featuring everything a weary cyclist could need, from bed and breakfasts to dining options to Bloom Brew, a small, family-owned brewery that has 24 beers on tap.

MILE 88.8 | CONNELLSVILLE

Once known as the "Coke Capital of the World" for its industrial prowess, GAP-lovers now recognize it as home to the Connellsville Gateway Arch, a 14-foot stained glass structure. Connellsville is a great place to spend the night, with a trailside hotel, bed and breakfasts, restaurants, and a bike shop.

MILE 71.9 | OHIOPYLE

One of the most popular stops between Pittsburgh and Washington, D.C., Ohiopyle is the perfect place for a day – or two – of fun off the GAP trail. Located inside of Ohiopyle State Park, the small town is an adventure lover's paradise that is home to whitewater rafting, fishing, hiking, and gorgeous views. A side trip to Frank Lloyd Wright's Fallingwater is a must for lovers of architecture.

Just a few miles into a GAP journey, it's easy to see why it was the first path inducted into the Rails-to-Trails Conservancy's Rail-Trail Hall of Fame. Much of what makes the Laurel Highlands an outdoor destination – such as sweeping views of waterfalls, river valleys, woodlands and wildlife – is on full display without ever leaving the crushed limestone path.

The well-maintained trail follows former railroad routes, meaning that even though it features an elevation change of 1,787 vertical feet, it's an easy ride that has an average grade of less than 1%. Casual riders can travel from one town to another while more energetic cyclists can make a multi-day trek filled with off-trail excursions thanks to the lodging, dining and bicycle shops located along the trail.

Those looking for an even longer adventure can hop on the C&O Canal Towpath – a more rugged 185-mile path that connects Cumberland to Washington, D.C., making it possible to cycle 330 miles to the nation's capital from Pittsburgh.



MILE 61.6 | CONFLUENCE

Named for the point where the Casselman River and Laurel Hill Creek meet to form the Youghiogheny River, this small town has reinvented itself thanks to trail tourism. Overnight options abound, from bed and breakfasts, to inns, cabins, camping, and glamping. Stop by Mitch's Fuel & Food to grab a snack or stock up on live bait and head out on the Youghiogheny River Lake for excellent trout fishing – a Pennsylvania fishing license is required.

MILE 43.8 | ROCKWOOD

From the moment cyclists pedal past the bicycle-themed metal sculptures, it's evident that Rockwood has embraced its role as a trail town. That's further evidenced by the large mural featuring a railroad engine and a bicycle with the motto "Building a future on our proud past." It's home to a small shopping district, bed and breakfasts, a hostel, and a pizzeria.

MILE 31.9 | MEYERSDALE

Sandwiched between two of the most scenic bridges on the trail – the 1,908-foot Salisbury Viaduct to the west and the 909-foot Keystone Viaduct to the east – Meyersdale is a memorable stop on the trail. The Big Savage Tunnel – the trail's longest – and the Eastern Continental Divide also are nearby, making the Maple City's boutique inn and bed and breakfasts popular overnight options.

Go for the Snow



It's easy to enjoy winter in the Laurel Highlands. Love to ski or board? Want to try snowmobiling? Is cross country skiing more your style? Then, go for the snow in the Laurel Highlands! Home to the world-renowned, all-inclusive Nemacolin resort and the awesome trifecta of Seven Springs Mountain Resort, Hidden Valley Ski Resort, and Laurel Mountain Ski Area, you'll find your winter groove in no time at all.



In 2021, Vail Resorts purchased Seven Springs, Hidden Valley, and Laurel Mountain and signaled not only an ownership change, but an opportunity for the region to be part of the national landscape. New options such as the Epic Pass – which provides access to Vail resorts across the country – make purchasing a ski pass in the Laurel Highlands an economically smart option.

Skiing and winter sports have been a tradition in the Laurel Highlands for generations, and your family can be part of that legacy. Make this the year that you start making mountain memories. Come for the day or stay for the week, the lodging options are plentiful and outdoor recreational opportunities are endless.

LAUREL MOUNTAIN, which was originally purchased and opened by the Mellon family, was the first full-service ski slope in the state of Pennsylvania. The first slopes were designed by Johann Schneider, a famous Austrian ski instructor who was imprisoned at one point by the Nazis and freed by American ski enthusiasts.

NEWBIES WELCOME: All three Vail resorts have robust ski schools offering programs for children and adults who want to hit the slopes for the first time or refresh their rusty skills. Adaptive ski lessons are available upon request at Hidden Valley and Seven Springs. The Special Olympics will also be returning to Seven Springs in 2023 after a pandemic hiatus.

FUN FACTS

The Laurel Highlands have long been a site of winter sports innovation. The first two ski tow ropes in the region were at Seven Springs and Hidden Valley, where they were run respectively by a Packard automobile and Ford tractor engines. Tow ropes were a revolution that changed skiing. Before that, skiers had to climb up the hill before coasting down. One of the original owners of Seven Springs, Herman Dupré, is also credited with developing several of the first snow machines in the world. The addition of these two modern changes shaped the face of skiing forever.

Campers

While there's a ton of family fun to be had together in the Laurel Highlands, there are also quite a few places to drop the kids off for the beloved tradition of summer camp. In the Laurel Highlands, kids can still, well, be kids. From tie-dye shirts and laughs around a campfire over s'mores, a summer camp with us hasn't changed much over the years. Camps fill quickly, so plan ahead!

SUMMER'S BEST TWO WEEKS – With two locations in the Laurel Highlands, this Christian sports camp lives up to its name. Whether families choose the Lake Gloria or Quemahoning Reservoir camp, kids will spend 14 days running, playing, learning, and growing in their faith. SB2W, as campers affectionately call it, also runs CitiKidz, a program focused on immersing children from urban environments in nature.

HANNA'S TOWN – This day camp, for ages 6-12, walks children through the time period when Pennsylvania was being colonized by European settlers. From blacksmithing to weaving, kids will be immersed in 18th-century life. Hanna's Town was the first seat of government for Westmoreland County and it is rich with history. While the town was burned during one of the last battles of the Revolutionary War, much has been preserved and rebuilt to create the historic site that visitors enjoy today year-round.

CAMP ALLEGHENY - Situated on over 100 acres of pristine farmland, Camp Allegheny has been a longstanding tradition in the Laurel Highlands and spans generations. The stable is full of horses and ponies available for year-round riding – yes, Camp Allegheny even has a winter camp for teens. They also host various retreats and an adult wrangler weekend in the spring.



the perfect fit

Whether you're looking for your camper to become one with nature, dive into rich history, or roll up their sleeves for an immersive arts and crafts experience, the summer camp programs available in the Laurel Highlands are plentiful. DAY CAMP sessions may be a great fit for your younger campers, while OVERNIGHT CAMP options are available to both youth and adult campers and can range from a few days on up to two weeks. Scan the QR code to view a full list of camps.



CAMP SOLES – "Every summer has a story," reads a plaque on the wall at Camp Soles. Campers have been creating stories at this 200-plus acre camp for more than six decades. This camp is brimming with activities like GaGa Ball, paddle boarding, and even an aqua trampoline. Those activities, says the staff at Camp Soles, serve as only the tools for the actual treasure of the summer. Camp Soles is committed to developing character, teaching kids how to build strong friendships, and teaching them responsibility. "The focus is definitely on fun and the personal growth comes with it!"

TOUCHSTONE CENTER FOR CRAFTS
TEEN WEEK - Participants (Ages 14-17) can get creative and immerse themselves in the arts on this beautiful wooded mountain campus. Participants will have access to fully equipped studio spaces while they live on campus where delicious home-cooked meals made with fresh local ingredients fuel their creativity. Evenings are open for demonstrations, group activities, or work in the studio. All students take a turn helping in the kitchen and keeping the campus clean. Teen Week Scholarships are available.







OHIOPYLE TREEHOUSE — Is there anything more whimsical than staying in a treehouse? This luxury treehouse in Ohiopyle is the grown-up fulfillment of a childhood dream. The two-bedroom house sleeps six and includes a two-story great room as well as sweeping views from the large deck. One perk over traditional treehouses — this house is completely ADA accessible.

LITTLE EVENTYR TINY HOUSE – Get in on the tiny house trend by staying at this 160-square foot home fully equipped with attention to every last detail. This spot sleeps up to four people, though the loft is best for kids and smaller adults. The campground where Little Eventyr is located boasts a pool, mini golf, clubhouse, and more to entertain guests during their stay.

YURTS AT BENNER'S MEADOW RUN — What's a yurt? It's essentially a round, standing-height tent with tons of space to spread out. The yurt has been used by different cultures for generations because of its functionality. At Benner's Meadow Run, there's also a touch of luxury. Yurts sleep four guests on a queen and twin hunks.

CONESTOGA WAGON LODGE AT YOGI BEAR'S JELLYSTONE PARK MILL RUN - This kitschy spot is perfect for parents who remember playing The Oregon Trail and kids who have no clue what that is. The covered wagon - which is thankfully stationary - sleeps six people in one queen bed and two twin bunks. Guests at the wagons have full use of everything Jellystone has to offer, from water slides to snowless snow tubing and more.

FROGGY TOP LODGE — This four-bedroom cabin that sleeps 11 guests is the quintessential mountain lodge. The deep wood tones that fill the space complement the expansive view of the mountains, and a separate gaming room gives guests some space to spread out. The property also contains a frog pond and a variety of outdoor recreation spaces ready for a game of cornhole or pickleball.

OAK LODGE — A true bed and breakfast in every sense of the word, guests at Oak Lodge will enjoy fresh breakfasts made on site as well as yoga and spa experiences. The property includes a variety of different lodging options and the café, which serves dinner daily. Don't forget to take home a jug of their Jimber maple syrup, which they've been producing on the property since 1998.

POLYMATH PARK - Polymath Park offers a rare opportunity to fully experience the architecture of Frank Lloyd Wright, with four homes in one location, all available for overnight lodging. Guests are encouraged to preserve, embrace, and live architecture during their visit. Escape from the fast pace of daily life, take in the architecture and simply return to nature. Your visit will be enhanced by the award-winning TreeTops Restaurant, complete with private dining pods for a treehouse dining experience.

PINE CREEK GLAMPING — Yes, it does say glamping. Yes, it's in the Laurel Highlands. Step out of the ordinary to a luxurious creekside camping escape quietly nestled on five wooded acres in the Laurel Highlands. All (or most) of the comforts of a luxury suite, enjoy the serenity of nature while remaining close to nearby attractions.









TOUCHSTONE CENTER FOR CRAFTS

Looking for a Creative Spark? For couples that love to create together, or just want to try something new, the Touchstone Center for Crafts in Farmington has unique date nights on select Friday evenings throughout the summer and fall. Couples can try blacksmithing, glass work, jewelry making, and more. At the conclusion of crafting, participants can unwind with wine provided by local Christian W. Klay Winery.

LEAF-PEEPING FOR TWO

Fall in Love All Over Again. Named one of USA Today's 10Best Destinations for Fall Foliage three years in a row, the Laurel Highlands offers a spectacular backdrop to a day of exploring. Couples can begin their day with a visit to one of the many fall festivals in the region followed by a trip to a local pumpkin patch to pick out the perfect jack-o-lantern. As evening sets in, duos can grab a flashlight and make their way through a multi-acre corn maze or snuggle together under the colorful autumn canopy on a hayride through the countryside. Afterwards, nothing beats sipping on authentic apple cider and cozying up to a crackling bonfire while warming up from the crisp autumn air.

GLADES PIKE WINERY

Sip & Savor On Saturday afternoons, music drifts across the vineyard at this local winery. A rotation of local bands is the perfect pairing for Glades Pike's bold reds or crisp whites. A gazebo overlooks the growing vines creating an idyllic setting. At select times throughout the year, couples can also enjoy a behind-the-scenes tour of the entire winemaking process with their very own "pour guide." Owners Steve and Karen Addleman founded this Somerset winery in 1995 after participating in a local wine club, and it's been a family-run business ever since.







EVERGREEN DRIVE-IN THEATRE

Nostalgic Romance Years ago, drive-ins were plentiful and the preferred venue for many first dates. Drive-ins have nearly disappeared, but the three screens at Evergreen in Mount Pleasant still show a collection of first-run and classic movies, rain or shine. The theater opened in 1947, and while it has changed names and ownership over the years, it maintains the classic appeal drive-ins are known for. Two snack bars serve sandwiches, popcorn, ice cream, soft drinks – and mosquito coils. Admission is cash-only, but the snack bars take credit cards.

JENNERSTOWN SPEEDWAY

Looking to Rev Up Your Date Night? How about a night at the races? Jennerstown Speedway has a colorful past dating back nearly a century, and some of the biggest names in auto racing history have competed at the half-mile asphalt oval over the years. In 2022, the NASCAR-certified track beat out rivals from across the nation in a community-engagement program that brought \$50,000 for improvements to Jennerstown. The track features five divisions of racing action every Saturday night from May to mid-September.



TAPPING INTO AGRITOURISM

The Laurel Highlands is the land of milk and honey ... and maple syrup and fruit and vegetables and ... well, you get the picture. The region has a rich agricultural history that has been reinvigorated by the farm-to-table movement.

While farming across the United States has become largely commercialized in recent years, the Laurel Highlands is still home to many smaller-scale, family-owned farms. Cindy and Dan Komarinski own one such farm in Fayette County. The 170-acre farm has been operating since the late 1770s. Cindy is proud of what they've built. "We are very fortunate that we have an amazing, gorgeous piece of property. We sell our certified American grass-fed beef by word of mouth." Komarinski Farm is one of 24 farms in Fayette County preserved by the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture. "To know this is going to stay a farm long after we are gone ... that's a legacy, that's important to us." The Komarinski family is working hard to preserve farmland in the region, as various family members have served on the agricultural preservation board. "It's a family affair," Cindy laughs.

Like the Komarinskis, the farmers at Sand Hill Berries in Mount Pleasant are committed to preserving agricultural life in the region. The Lynn and Schilling families purchased a defunct farm in 1981 and have built a business growing red raspberries, red currants, black currants, gooseberries, blackberries, blueberries, and strawberries. The farm store sells their produce, desserts, preserves, and more. Their berries have even graced the table at two White House state dinners. In 2007, they opened Greendance Winery, which utilizes fruit grown on the farm for wine production. Guests are invited to sit and sip in the Nectar Garden while enjoy a meal from the Cabin Café.

There is also a vibrant cheese and honey production scene in the Laurel Highlands. The Creamery at Pleasant Lane Farms in Latrobe is home to almost 100 dairy cows and over 50,000 bees. Their products are sold throughout the western Pennsylvania region, but visitors can come right to the farm to see the process in action. Visitors can tour the farm, fuss over baby calves in the spring, and even get a lesson in cheese-making. The Smart Barn, with robotic milking, is an interesting look at modern-day farming in a historical setting. While the Frye family has been operating the farm since 1976, they enjoy the mix of history and innovation that their farm showcases.

farmers markets

LIGONIER COUNTRY MARKET - Over 100 vendors gather on Saturdays for this large market with produce, meat, crafts, and more. The market was voted best farmers market in PA in 2022.

SOMERSET COUNTY FARMERS MARKET – On Saturdays, this produce-only market is held with a goal of increasing access to healthy, fresh food in the region.

BUSHY RUN MARKET – Held the fourth Saturday of every month at the Bushy Run Battlefield, visitors receive free coffee or tea while they peruse the goods.

LIGONIER NIGHT MARKET - Forty vendors gather on the third Thursday of every month on the Ligonier Diamond.

SPRINGS FARMERS MARKET - One of the largest markets in the area, this was voted Best Farmers Market in Somerset County. It is held on Saturdays.



Want to take some of these locally grown goods home with you? There is no shortage of farmers markets in the Laurel Highlands. Most run through the summer and fall. Check their websites for the most up-to-date hours and dates before visiting.



the *sweet spot*

No other county in Pennsylvania produces more maple syrup than Somerset County. The region's first maple producers began tapping trees in 1762, and the industry has only grown since. Maple festivals abound through the region, brimming with sweet treats and gallons of sticky syrup. At Brantview Farm, eight generations of the same family have been making maple syrup since 1832. They are open for tours year-round and display over 100 antiques for visitors to the camp. Brantview Farms always participates in the Somerset County Taste & Tour, a yearly springtime event that celebrates local maple camps.

Like Brantview Farms, the Sechler Sugar Shack has been a family-owned business for generations. "Our family has been making maple syrup since 1850. My great-great-grandfather, Jonas Meyers, began making maple syrup in 1850. He even paid a federal tax on maple sugar," says Everett Sechler. Also participants in the Taste & Tour, the Sechlers are known for their whimsical and unique syrup containers – ranging in shape from a hockey player, to a maple leaf, to the Statue of Liberty.


