Keep our region BEAUTIFUL

Here at GO Laurel Highlands, we are thrilled to welcome visitors to our unique and remarkable outdoor recreation area. We believe the natural beauty in the Laurel Highlands rivals top destinations around the world – but we need your help to keep it that way. Follow these tips for responsible recreation so generations to come can continue to enjoy the Laurel Highlands.

EXPLORE RESPONSIBLY

LEAVE NO TRACE.

If you take something into a natural area, take it with you when you leave. Everyone deserves to see the same pristine location, plus your trash can harm local flora and fauna.

DON'T FEED THE BEARS – OR ANY WILDLIFE.

While the Laurel Highlands is home to one picnic-basket stealing bear at Yogi Bear's Jellystone Park in Mill Run, the rest of our wildlife is, well, wild. Don't feed, pet, chase, or disturb them in any way, outside of legally licensed fishing and hunting in designated areas. This is their home, too.

BE CONSIDERATE OF OTHERS.

Remember that we are all sharing the natural areas. Be mindful of noise levels, respectful of rules and regulations, and generally be kind to anyone you encounter. Know the symptoms of COVID-19, and if you don't feel well, stay home.

USE FIRE RESPONSIBLY.

If you choose to make a fire for cooking or telling ghost stories at night, do so only in dedicated areas. Pay attention to ranger warnings about fire risks during dry seasons. Keep a bucket of water nearby, and don't go to bed with a lit fire. One careless mistake could cause catastrophic damage.

PROTECT OUR WATER SOURCES.

The Laurel Highlands is home to dozens of creeks, rivers, waterfalls, and lakes. Be mindful of what you dump, where you dump it, and how it might impact the waterways around you. Washing your camping dishes in a creek might feel harmless, but it is introducing more pollutants into the environment.

TAKE ONLY PHOTOS AND MEMORIES.

If every visitor took a stone, flower, or fossil on their visit, eventually there would be very little left for others to enjoy. We want you to thoroughly enjoy your trip, but please leave it how you found it.

HONORING HISTORY IN THE LAUREL HIGHLANDS

Celebrate America's 250TH

Fort Necessity National Battlefield

***A**s America gears up for its 250th birthday in 2026, the celebration has already begun in Pennsylvania's Laurel Highlands, a region steeped in history. This area, rich in cultural sites, offers travelers a unique chance to experience key moments from America's past.*

FORT NECESSITY

Where Washington's Leadership Began

In 1754, a young George Washington was tasked with building a westward military supply road and established a permanent encampment in the Great Meadows. There, he constructed Fort Necessity, which became the site of the first battle of the French and Indian War. Although Washington's forces surrendered, this event marked the beginning of his illustrious military career. Today, you can visit Fort Necessity National Battlefield, explore its museum, watch a feature film, and walk through the restored fort. Nearby, the Liberty Tree at Mount Washington's Inn commemorates America's 250th anniversary.

FORT LIGONIER

The Road to the Revolution

In 1758, an impressive fortification was built along the newly cut Forbes Road which overlooked the Loyalhanna Creek. Today, Fort Ligonier is one of the

finest reconstructed fortifications from the French and Indian War. Historical interpreters talk about soldiering and the rigors of 18th century life. Visit the Washington Gallery to learn how his "Friendly Fire Incident" impacted the future founding father and changed the course of the French and Indian War. Don't miss the beautiful portrait of Queen Charlotte and other original art works and the restored parlor of Arthur St. Clair.

FLIGHT 93 MEMORIAL

A Tribute to Modern Heroes

The Laurel Highlands also holds a more recent chapter in American history. On September 11, 2001, the passengers and crew of Flight 93 heroically fought back against hijackers, preventing further tragedy. The Flight 93 National Memorial in Shanksville honors these brave individuals with a Visitor Center, educational programs, and the Tower of Voices, a musical tribute to the 40 heroes. As the 25th anniversary of 9/11 approaches, Somerset County has dedicated their 250th celebrations to volunteers and first responders.

Visiting the Laurel Highlands offers a journey through time, where the American spirit of courage and resilience shines bright.



Honor & Remember at **FLIGHT 93** **NATIONAL MEMORIAL**

*“A common field one day.
A field of honor forever.”*

Those words, which adorn the overlook at the Flight 93 National Memorial near Shanksville, still ring true nearly a quarter century after a hijacked Boeing 757 violently crashed into the earth in Somerset County.

A large boulder now stoically marks the crash site of United Airlines Flight 93, honoring the 40 passengers and crew members who lost their lives in that field on Sept. 11, 2001.

Nearly a half-million visitors come to the memorial each year to pay tribute to those 40 men and women, but it still maintains a tranquility that belies the violence that took place in the skies above.

The Tower of Voices provides a soundtrack for the memorial, giving an eternal voice to those who lost their lives aboard Flight 93. On a windy day, the 40 wind chimes of the 93-foot tall landmark create a melodic symphony like no other in the world.

The Visitors Center, open from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily, is an educational but moving tribute to the events that began early on the morning of Sept. 11. It features a permanent exhibition that focuses on the Flight 93 story within the context of the larger terrorist attack, including a self-guided experience around artifacts, multimedia and interactive exhibits. The museum store offers a variety of souvenirs, such as challenge coins, postcards, magnets, and park ranger-recommended books.

A stroll along the park's Memorial Plaza allows time for reflection. The walkway follows a quarter-mile long path along the northern boundary of the crash site and leads to the Wall of Names, which pays tribute with the name of each passenger or crew member inscribed on one of the 40 polished marble stones.

When you visit the Flight 93 National Memorial, plan to include two other nearby tributes. **Remember Me Rose Garden** serves as a "living memorial" to Flight 93's passengers and crew, while **Patriot Park** honors armed forces with a display of more than 7,000 American flags representing the men and women who have lost their lives in the nation's efforts to eradicate terrorism.





Plan a Laurel Highlands FUN-FOR-ALL!

The Laurel Highlands has been synonymous with family fun for nearly 150 years. Come out to play!

Idlewild & SoakZone in Ligonier, which has been named the “Best Children’s Park” by Amusement Today, has been the place to play in the Laurel Highlands since 1878.

A trolley ride tour of Daniel Tiger’s Neighborhood is always a special experience for tiny tots, while a stroll through Story Book Forest makes fairy tales come alive. The Wild Mouse and Round Up are great for teens and adults.

SoakZone delivers cool experiences for all age levels, from the Little Squirts kiddie pool and Float Away Bay lazy river to the downhill excitement of the Serpentine Slides and Hydro Races.

ANIMAL ENCOUNTERS

Looking to see a brown bear or a white tiger in the Laurel Highlands? Or maybe something a bit more cuddly, like a baby kangaroo? **Living Treasures Animal Park**, located near the Pennsylvania Turnpike in Donegal, is the place for animal lovers, with more than 300 creatures.

Located on the same property as Living Treasures, **Log Cabin Lodge and Suites** offers a perfect place for families to stay while visiting the Laurel Highlands, with suites ranging from one to six bedrooms, and 50% discount on admission to the animal park.

Located on nearly 1,000 acres of rolling hills in Somerset County, the **Pittsburgh Zoo & Aquarium's International Conservation Center (ICC)** seems an odd place to find African elephants roaming, but this extension of the zoo provides the perfect landscape to focus on conservation science, wildlife management and recovery, and education. The ICC opens to the public on select dates for wagon rides, wild encounters and special events.



Little Blessings Farm in Avonmore offers the chance to snuggle with Highland calves, goats, babydoll sheep and kune kune pigs, but it's more than just a petting zoo. While the petting zoo is weather-dependent, an artisan boutique is open year-round.

THE NEED FOR SPEED

Put the pedal to the metal on family fun with a visit to **Caddie Shak Family Fun Center** in Donegal. Caddie Shak has an array of go-kart options with a long track, a fast track and a kiddie track.

If you'd rather leave the driving to the professionals, check out six divisions of stock car racing action at **Jennerstown Speedway** each Saturday night from May through mid-September. Get your motors running with this family friendly option, which includes free parking and free admission for children under age 12.

Full Throttle Adrenaline Park in Monroeville is a high-speed haven with pro karts (14 years and older), junior karts (7 and older) and mini karts (3 to 6 years). The Sodikart – RTX models can get up to 40 mph on the track!

In addition to go-karts, Full Throttle has axe throwing, a rage room and break bar plus an arcade with everything from classic games to virtual reality experiences.



PUTTERING AROUND

Miniature golf is a big deal in the Laurel Highlands!

Walnut Hill Miniature Golf in Uniontown includes a scenic but challenging 18-hole course and the Wave Runner Café features frozen custard that is made fresh daily. It's delicious, whether you get it in a cone, a sundae or a milkshake.

When one round just isn't enough, check out **Caddie Shak Family Fun Center** in Donegal, which has a pair of 18-hole courses – the Olde Course and the Highlander. If you'd rather swing than putt, Caddie Shak has a driving range and batting cage.

Yogi Bear's Jellystone Park in Mill Run features an 18-hole miniature golf course that is open to campers and non-campers. If you prefer backstrokes to golf strokes, go for a swim at Yogi Bear's Wetlands, relax by the Lower Pool or take an exciting ride down the Water Slide. If playing WITH the water is more your style, try your hand at a game of Water Wars or cool off in the Lower Spray Zone!

Your Way

Ninety years after Frank Lloyd Wright designed Fallingwater, the Laurel Highlands has become a global destination for those fascinated by his work.

In addition to Fallingwater, which instantly became one of the most recognizable private residences in the world and is now a UNESCO World Heritage site, the region is home to three other Wright-designed homes as well as several with designs influenced by the architectural master.

So, what types of people visit Fallingwater, Kentuck Knob and Polymath Park – which includes Wright’s Mäntylä and Duncan House as well as two homes designed by Wright protégé Peter Berndtson?

THE ARCHITECTURE LOVER | The Laurel Highlands is a bucket-list trip for those who chart their journeys on graph paper. From the cantilevered design and “invisible” corner windows at Fallingwater to the hexagonal cutouts on the terrace roof at Kentuck Knob and the meticulously reconstructed lines of Mäntylä, there’s an intriguing story at every turn. Those looking for a little more time to study these masterpieces can book overnight stays at Polymath Park.

THE INTERIOR DESIGNER | Wright was decades ahead of his time – he paved the way for the mid-century modern movement – and his homes still inspire creative ideas today.

THE ARTIST | Fallingwater is home to works by legendary artists such as Pablo Picasso and Diego Rivera, and each year the Fallingwater Institute welcomes visiting artists/scholars of exceptional talent to live, study, and work at the historic site. The current owner of Kentuck Knob, Lord Peter Palumbo, previously served as chair of the Arts Council of Great Britain, and an art walk around the grounds is a perfect way to end a tour.

THE HISTORY BUFF | The fact that Fallingwater was designed and built during the Great Depression makes it even more remarkable. Perhaps nothing demonstrates the length of Wright’s incredible career better than the furniture in the living room at Kentuck Knob, which serves as a historical timeline ranging from a turn-of-the-century recliner to a 1950s-era office chair that still looks futuristic today.

THE OUTDOORSY TYPE | Edgar and Liliane Kaufmann would probably love to see hiking boots on visitors touring their historic home. The location was chosen, in part, because of their love for the outdoors. Fallingwater is also part of the Bear Run Nature Preserve and is located just outside Ohiopyle State Park, which draws more than a million visitors each year.

THE STUDENT | Everyone from elementary pupils to graduate students make their way to these hallowed houses. Fallingwater and Kentuck Knob each feature gift shops with reading material on Wright and architecture. Fallingwater Institute welcomes virtual summer camps, high school programs and college residencies.

THE FOODIE | A brunch, lunch or dinner tour of Polymath Park's homes combines Wright's exquisite architecture with an incredible dining experience at TreeTops Restaurant. The Fallingwater Café is committed to serving locally sourced meals onsite, and Fallingwater

Institute periodically hosts an exclusive Forest-to-Table Dinner and a private tour of the home. Be sure to sample the ice cream at Kentuck Knob, which was built by I.N. and Bernadine Hagan, owners of the Hagan Ice Cream Co. in Uniontown.

THE INSTAGRAMMER | Add these to your social media for instant clout: A photo from the iconic view of Fallingwater, one of the Youghiogheny River Gorge from behind Kentuck Knob (bonus points if it's in autumn) and another from a private dining pod during a twilight dinner at TreeTops Restaurant at Polymath Park.

YOU | Don't know a buttress from a hole in the ground? You don't have to be an expert to enjoy Fallingwater, which a poll of the American Institute of Architects named the "best all-time work of American architecture." Use the tips above to find delicious meals, fantastic photos and unforgettable experiences.

Head to the mountains! There's snow much to do in the Laurel Highlands when the weather turns cold.

With more than 285 acres of ski and snowboard terrain, **Seven Springs Mountain Resort** is one of the most popular cold-weather destinations in Pennsylvania. Home to 33 trails and ten lifts, Seven Springs is a favorite for skiers and snowboarders. Ski and board lessons and a snow tubing park provide thrills for all snow lovers. Enjoy a bite to eat at Helen's, the Slopeside Restaurant or the Foggy Goggle – named the No. 1 après-ski bar in North America by USA Today readers – and then stay for an unforgettable weekend getaway.

Hidden Valley Resort and **Laurel Mountain Resort** are each located within a short drive of Seven Springs. Vail Resorts Epic Pass includes all three resorts.

Hidden Valley is a family-friendly resort with 28 slopes and trails, two terrain parks, eight lifts and excellent ski and snowboard schools. Clocktower, Glaciers Pub and Sunrise Sunset Cafe offer a variety of dining options. Stay in a **Highlands Ventures Cabin** with ski-in, ski-out access.

Laurel Mountain has 70 acres of skiable terrain, with 20 trails and two lifts. It's best known for the iconic double diamond Lower Wildcat, which has an average slope of almost 60%, making it one of the steepest in the state.

Cross country skiing and snowshoeing are also quite popular in the Laurel Highlands in **Forbes State Forest**, **Laurel Mountain State Park**, **Laurel Ridge State Park** and **Roaring Run Natural Area**.

Get your motor running with snowmobiling options in **Forbes State Forest**, **Ohio State Park** and **Laurel Hill State Park**.

The Laurel Highlands region comes alive in the spring, as the temperatures climb, the flowers bloom and outdoor recreation kicks into high gear.

Mountain Ridge ATV Park in Central City offers ATV, UTV and dirt bike owners a chance to get out and ride, with more than 150 miles of trails and 40 miles of single track on 3,000 acres. Mountain Ridge continues to add to its lodging options, with primitive camping, campsites with electric hookups and rustic cabins available.

For anglers, spring in the Laurel Highlands means the start of trout season. With cool mountain waters in creeks, streams, rivers and lakes, the region is home to some of the best fishing in the state. Somerset County has more approved trout streams than any county in the state. The **Laurel Highlands Trout Trail** is the best way to find out about trout fishing in the region.

Waterfall lovers can take advantage of spring weather to see easy-to-reach spots such as Ohiopyle Falls and the nearby Cucumber Falls. Ohiopyle State Park provides one of the best waterfall hikes in Southwestern Pennsylvania with access to four impressive waterfalls. **Frank Lloyd Wright's Fallingwater** – the UNESCO World Heritage Site featuring a home built over a waterfall – is a must-see, while the lesser-known Packsaddle Bridge in Somerset County is the only covered bridge over a waterfall in Pennsylvania.

Pennsylvania's largest cave, **Laurel Caverns**, is in Uniontown. Rain is never an issue and it's always 52 degrees inside the caverns, which have more than four miles of underground passages. It generally opens in late April or early May.

Make a splash in the Laurel Highlands with easily accessible waterways.

Paddling the waters of the Youghiogheny and Stonycreek rivers are popular options. The Yough features some of the best whitewater experiences in the eastern United States. Outfitters such as **Laurel Highlands River Tours & Outdoor Center**, **Ohiopyle Trading Post and River Tours**, **White Water Adventurers** and **Wilderness Voyageurs** offer family-friendly floats on the Middle Yough to more adventurous trips down the Lower Yough. Thrill seekers can take on the Upper Yough for heart-pounding Class IV and V rapids.

Canoeing and kayaking is popular in the Laurel Highlands, with rental options available in **Keystone State Park**, **Laurel Hill State Park** and **Ohiopyle**.

The beaches at **Keystone State Park**, **Laurel Hill State Park** and **Quemahoning Family Recreation Area** are a cool escape from the heat. The truly adventurous love sliding down the **Meadow Run Natural Waterslide** in Ohiopyle.

Hundreds of miles of hiking trails crisscross the region. Backpackers love the **Laurel Highlands Hiking Trail**, a 70-mile thru hike with conveniently located shelter areas perfect for multi-day trips. A great hike can be found in any of the eight state parks and two state forests in the Laurel Highlands.

🍁 | FALL

The **Great Allegheny Passage** is spectacular any time of year but fall might be the best season to experience one of the nation's best recreational trails. Cyclists from around the world take on the 150-mile thru ride from Pittsburgh to Cumberland, Maryland, with some opting to pick up the **C&O Canal Trail** and ride to Washington, D.C., for a staggering 330-mile journey.

Many businesses in the Laurel Highlands cater to cyclists, including **Maple Leaf Outfitters** and **Sunshine Luggage Shuttle**, both of which will transport your luggage from one lodging accommodation to another.

The GAP is rarely crowded, but fall allows riders even more solitude, and the trail is spectacular once the leaves begin to change colors in late September. Cooler temperatures make for a more comfortable ride, and October is historically one of the driest months in the Laurel Highlands.

Leaf peeping is one of the biggest reasons visitors flock to the Laurel Highlands, as Pennsylvania features a longer and more varied fall foliage season than anywhere in the world. USA Today readers took notice, naming **Keystone State Park** the nation's best fall foliage destination in 2023, and vibrant oranges, reds and yellows make autumn drives through the Laurel Highlands an incredible experience. Climb the observation tower at **Forbes State Forest's Mount Davis**, the highest point in Pennsylvania, for an incredible vantage point.

MUSIC

Fills the Mountains

The Highlands are alive with the sound of music, to borrow a phrase from a popular movie.

Built into a hillside near Farmington, **Timber Rock Amphitheater**, which opened in 2023, delivers panoramic views of the Laurel Highlands and optimal acoustic value. With the ability to seat about 4,000 fans, Timber Rock hosts legendary country music acts with plans to expand its schedule and lineup in the future.

The Palace Theatre in Greensburg plays host to some of the biggest names in music. From Motown legends to Rock 'n Roll Hall of Famers and country, blues and jazz greats, they've all played The Palace.

The **Lamp Theatre** in Irwin, opened in 1937, now shines a spotlight on local music with its summer series and popular rock and pop tribute bands.

Windber's historic **Arcadia Theater** opened in 1921 and now welcomes tribute acts and seasonal performances each year.

Several parks in the Laurel Highlands also serve as popular music venues. St. Clair Park in Greensburg hosts **SummerSounds**, a weekly free concert series with acts that run the musical gamut from jazz to country to rock. The **AmeriServ Flood City Music Festival**, presented by the Johnstown Area Heritage Association, is a two-day concert spread over three stages at Peoples Natural Gas Park in Johnstown each summer. The **Laurel Hill Bluegrass Festival**, held at Laurel Hill State Park, and the **Ligonier Valley Bluegrass Festival** in Ligonier draw fans of the traditional musical style from far and wide.

A ROADTRIP FOR YOUR TASTEBUDS

If you're looking for a weekend getaway that you can really sink your teeth into, check out some fabulous foodie options in the Laurel Highlands.

1 | DEER CREEK WINERY & WATSON ESTATE UNIONTOWN

Start by booking a room at the Deer Creek Winery & Watson Estate in Uniontown. This beautifully secluded bed and breakfast inn offers a blend of modern conveniences with the ambiance of early America. You'll be greeted with a free glass of wine of your choice – and a chance to add a location to your Laurel Highlands Pour Tour passport. Wake up to a full country breakfast that will fuel your first day in the Laurel Highlands, which can include a hike on the paved path to the Cross of Christ at Jumonville and a visit to Fort Necessity National Battlefield or a shopping excursion in Uniontown.

2 | BITTERSWEET CAFE FARMINGTON

Make your way to the Bittersweet Café outside Farmington, where fresh and local are always on the menu. The Bittersweet Burger is a large slab of angus – no antibiotics or growth hormones – topped with a Footprints Farm egg, a blend of provolone and white cheddar, crispy bacon, and drizzled with house red pepper jelly on a homemade bun. Add a baked treat or handcrafted drink to top off the experience.

WHILE IN THE AREA...

Head into Ohiopyle to grab a picture of the falls and go for a hike in the Ferncliff Peninsula Natural Area, or, if you've booked tickets ahead of time, visit Frank Lloyd Wright's Fallingwater, a UNESCO World Heritage site in nearby Mill Run. Be sure to check out Baughman Rock Overlook for stunning views of the Youghiogheny River Gorge just steps from the parking lot.

3-4 | RIVER'S EDGE CAFE & HARTZELL HOUSE BED & BREAKFAST CONFLUENCE, ADDISON

Dinner at the River's Edge Café in Confluence is a delight, especially if you're able to sit outside on the wrap-around porch next to the Youghiogheny River on a warm summer evening. Seafood is a specialty at the River's Edge, where you'll swear that the stuffed rainbow trout was just pulled from the Yough. Located near the Great Allegheny Passage, the River's Edge also has a small bed-and-breakfast, with three rooms, or you can make the short drive south to the Hartzell House Bed and Breakfast in Addison. Known for its "casual luxury," the Hartzell House is a five-star property on TripAdvisor that has become renowned for its outstanding omelets and waffles.

5 | OUT OF THE FIRE CAFÉ

DONEGAL

Head north for lunch at Out of the Fire Café in Donegal – don't miss the signature smoked salmon – and enjoy the incredible views from the deck. Visit nearby Living Treasures Animal Park or Caddie Shak for a dose of family-friendly fun.

6 | TREETOPS RESTAURANT AT POLYMATH PARK

ACME

Cap your day with a truly unforgettable experience with a twilight dinner at TreeTops Restaurant at Polymath Park. Book ahead and enjoy four and a half courses of handcrafted culinary plates served in a private treehouse-style dining pod plus a glass of bubbly and coffee or tea with dessert.

7 | OAK LODGE

STAHLSTOWN

Discover Oak Lodge near Stahlstown, where you can book a private cabin or a suite within the main lodge for a delightful blend of rustic and luxurious surroundings. Wake up to a lovely breakfast that rotates menu options but always includes local coffee and house-made granola. Relax with a couples massage and find inner peace with a reiki energy balancing session or embrace forest bathing courtesy of Whispering Woods Spa. The Café at Oak Lodge is found in the heart of the faux 18th-century Jimberg Village and is open to the public year-round with a seasonal menu featuring a variety of weekly dinner specials.

8 | CONNECTIONS CAFÉ

LIGONIER

Discover a light, healthy lunch at Connections Café in Ligonier, followed by some retail therapy in the incredibly shoppable small town filled with boutique shops and galleries. Take a break from shopping with some candy made the “old-fashioned” way at O’Shea’s Ligonier Sweet Shoppe. With four generations of family ownership, O’Shea’s uses the same methods that their grandparents developed more than 80 years ago.

9 | LINCOLN HIGHWAY EXPERIENCE

LATROBE

If time allows, visit the Lincoln Highway Experience in Latrobe, the museum dedicated to America’s first coast-to-coast highway, where each guest receives a free slice of pie and a cup of coffee in the 1930s-style diner.

10 | J. CORKS

GREENSBURG

Finish your long weekend in style with dinner at J. Corks in Greensburg, which offers high-end American fare – ranging from a surf-n-turf mac-and-cheese to filet mignon – and allows patrons to choose their atmosphere with a full bar, formal dining room, and patio.



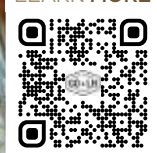

Shoppers find a wide variety of artisanal works and handmade crafts as well as locally grown produce and baked goods in the Laurel Highlands.

Ligonier Country Market has been honored as the best farmers market in the state. The oldest and largest market in Western Pennsylvania takes place each Saturday at Loyalhanna Watershed Farm from May until October. About 120 vendors sell products from pierogies to handcrafted furniture.

The **SoCo Farmers Market** in Somerset brings farm-fresh food and hand-crafted goods to Uptown Somerset on Saturday mornings from June to mid-October, while the **Springs Farmers Market** is part local produce and part flea market with freshly made doughnuts and pastries each Saturday morning in Somerset County's Amish country.

Cinder Shack's 15,000 square feet in Farmington has the feel of an outdoor market. The multi-vendor marketplace has products from more than 100 local artisans and antique shops.

Neubauer's Flowers and Market House, located in the restored U.S. Livery Building in Uniontown, offers an array of home decor, silk arrangements and wreaths, home fragrance, gardenware and outdoor plants, and year-round Christmas merchandise.

In Somerset, **Baker's Home & Garden Center** is a one-stop garden shop with a curated collection of home decor, candles, seasonal decorations, hand-crafted furniture and massive selection of seasonal plantings.

Compass Inn Museum

H *istory is always on display in the Laurel Highlands.*

Two hundred years ago, the **Compass Inn Museum and Historic Site** in Laughlintown served as a popular inn for travelers on the Philadelphia-Pittsburgh Turnpike. Now, the authentically restored stagecoach hostelry and tavern welcomes guests of a different sort. Dressed in 1830s period clothing, docents take visitors on an entertaining and informative tour through the original inn and three reconstructed outbuildings. Special events at the Compass Inn include Living History Weekends, Halloween Storytelling, Harvest Tours and the very popular Holiday Candlelight Tours.

Just 12 miles down Route 30 in Latrobe, the **Lincoln Highway Experience** tells a much different story of travelers. Dedicated to America’s first coast-to-coast road, which stretched from New York City to San Francisco, the 5,000-square-foot museum includes audio wands for custom tours at 16 stops. Admission also includes a free cup of coffee and slice of pie inside the restored Serro’s Diner.

Did you know that the Laurel Highlands claims first shots fired in the French and Indian War? Artifacts verify this was indeed the case at Jumonville Glen, part of **Fort Necessity National Battlefield** in Farmington. Lieutenant Colonel George Washington commanded the troops

in this 15-minute skirmish in 1754 which launched the Seven Years’ War. Learn all about this battle and more at Fort Necessity.

The **Rivers of Steel Natural Heritage Area** offers unique experiences across eight counties, including the Laurel Highlands. Sightseeing tours of the Carrie Blast Furnaces and excursions on the Explorer riverboat, which are offered regularly from late spring to early fall, are especially popular in Pittsburgh.

“A Steelworker’s Story,” is told from a different perspective as the exhibit at the **Heritage Discovery Center** in Johnstown includes signs, product samples and personal effects from steelworkers. “Forging a Nation: Johnstown Iron & Steel” opened in 2024 to rave reviews, as the three-story permanent exhibit draws extensively from the Johnstown Area Heritage Association’s collection and includes newly acquired artifacts. A 25-minute film – “The Mystery of Steel” – chronicles the rise and fall of the industry in Johnstown.

There's always something to celebrate in the Laurel Highlands – from banana splits to UFO sightings!

The **Fire and Ice Festival** is one of the hottest events in the region, as dozens of ice sculptures are crafted around Uptown Somerset. Held around the Martin Luther King Jr. holiday, the event is free to attend and includes live music, an ice slide and fireworks.

Dozens of boutique shops, art galleries and restaurants always make Ligonier a great place to walk and shop, but January's annual **Ice Fest** provides an even more charming experience in this quaint borough often referred to as a "Hallmark Christmas" town.

March and April are the sweetest months on the events calendar, as Somerset County Maple Producers present **Maple Taste & Tour Weekends** and the **Pennsylvania Maple Festival**. Somerset produces more maple than any county in the state, and Meyersdale has celebrated the industry for nearly 80 years with delicious foods, handmade crafts and contests.

Ohiopyle Borough celebrates the Youghiogheny in late May/early June with its **Spirit of the River: Ohiopyle Wine and Arts Festival**. The event supports the borough, which was named the Best Small Town in the Northeast in 2024, and includes wine and spirit tasting, arts and craft vendors.

Westmoreland Arts & Heritage Festival

The **Westmoreland Arts and Heritage Festival** recently celebrated its 50th year. Held at Twin Lakes Park in Greensburg each July, it features visual and live performing arts, traditional and fine crafts, cultural heritage activities and tasty ethnic foods.

Seven Springs Mountain Resort brings the ultimate backyard barbecue experience to the Laurel Highlands each July with its annual Rib & Wing Festival. Some of the nation's top rib-and-wing makers gather for this saucy experience that also includes live music and games.

The **Kecksburg UFO Festival** provides an out-of-this-world experience. A highly publicized incident on Dec. 9, 1965, has led some to refer to the tiny unincorporated area in Westmoreland County as "Pennsylvania's Roswell." Each July, festival attendees come dressed as their favorite alien for information on the unexplained as well as food, games and fireworks.

Uptown Somerset's **Chalk the Block** festival brings art to the streets in July, with chalk artists from across the country demonstrating their fun and creative works. Art demonstrations and free kids' activities "draw" even more people to the event.

Thousands of vinophiles unite each August for Seven Springs Mountain Resort's annual **Wine Festival**. This huge celebration features nearly two dozen Pennsylvania wineries with complimentary sampling as well as wine available for purchase.

What's better than a scoop of ice cream on a hot summer day? Three scoops of ice cream, of course. Latrobe celebrates one of its signature inventions in August with the **Great American Banana Split Festival**.

The **Bedford Fall Foliage Festival** was named one of the most popular autumn celebrations in the country by OprahDaily.com. The event, which is centered in Bedford's historic downtown over two weekends in October, brings the best local arts, crafts and culture together in the crisp mountain air just outside the Laurel Highlands.

Fort Ligonier Days annually commemorates a key French and Indian War battle from Oct. 12, 1758. The three-day festival features historic battle reenactments, top-rated juried crafts, delicious foods, local spirits, live music and a grand parade.

It might be one of the newest local festivals, but **Bonfires, Barrels and Brews** quickly became a favorite for craft beverage lovers. The Laurel Highlands Pour Tour passport program brings breweries, wineries and distilleries together with food and craft vendors for an autumn celebration of the region's spirits.

During the holiday season, head to **Overly's Country Christmas®** at the Westmoreland Fairgrounds on select dates in November and December. This Christmas Village is filled with old-fashioned traditions such as a model train display, pictures with Santa and horse-drawn wagon/sleigh rides.

Wander Ridge in Mill Run has family-friendly domes that offer a unique camping experience with plush queen beds, wood burning stoves and solar lighting. **Benner's Meadow Run RV Campground** near Ohiopyle has tent and RV sites as well as yurts and cabins. **Pine Creek Glamping** in Stoystown offers a luxurious creekside

escape with a cozy king bed, heat and air conditioning and refrigerator.

One of the top RV campgrounds in the country according to USA Today readers, **Yogi Bear's Jellystone Park Camp-Resort** in Mill Run adds family fun to the camping experience. Home to more than 3,400 objects of fine and decorative art, **The Westmoreland Museum of American Art** is a free regional museum with a national presence. Located in Greensburg, the museum itself is a work of art. The cantilever wing recalls one of the most famous buildings in the Laurel Highlands – or the world – in Frank Lloyd Wright’s Fallingwater and has been hailed for its architectural design.

Exhibitions slated for 2025 include “All the Right Notes,” which presents artworks and objects inspired by the ethereality of music, and “George Hetzel and Scalp Level,” which celebrates the rich artistic heritage of Southwestern Pennsylvania and the profound influence that George Hetzel and his students had in the late 19th and early 20th centuries.

Touchstone Center for Crafts is a creative community located on 230 acres of lush woodlands near Farmington. In addition to exhibition and retail galleries, which showcase the talent of local, regional and national artists, Touchstone offers artist residencies and internships for emerging artists. Multi-day workshops range from blacksmithing and glass to drawing and painting. Date nights are the perfect way to try your hand at a new craft in a fun environment.

The **Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art** includes several locations including one in Ligonier. SAMA offers a full schedule of exhibits, programs and activities including a variety of educational activities for kids of all ages.

Pittsburgh Steelers Training Camp at
Saint Vincent College

The Laurel Highlands has served as Pittsburgh's playground for more than a century, and for good reason. The region's forests, rivers and mountains have provided an escape from city life since at least the 1880s, when a roundtrip train ticket to Ohiopyle was just \$1.

Today's travelers will notice Laurel Highlands signage at Pittsburgh International Airport, and those who still love to ride the rails can take Amtrak from the Steel City to Greensburg, Connellsville and Latrobe. Most visitors prefer taking the wheel to get here from Pittsburgh, as most of the Laurel Highlands is located within a 30- to 90-minute drive of the city.

Fans of the Pittsburgh Steelers have been escaping to the mountains since the football team started holding their Training Camp at Saint Vincent College in Latrobe more than 50 years ago. The chance to get an early glimpse of the team – or an autograph from a favorite player – draws thousands each summer. Tickets are free but need to be obtained online in advance.

The Laurel Highlands is recognized as A Preferred Vacation Destination of the Pittsburgh Steelers, meaning the organization will help its global fanbase discover this wonderful area. Cameron Heyward, one of the team's most popular players and the 2023 Walter Payton Man of the Year Award winner for his charitable actions, has joined GO Laurel Highlands to help promote the region and its assets.

The link between Pittsburgh and the Laurel Highlands runs even deeper than the waters of the Youghiogheny and Monongahela rivers, which eventually end up in the Ohio River at Pittsburgh's Point State Park. The same waterways that connected the city and countryside through transportation and industry now unite them through outdoor recreation.

The Great Allegheny Passage - a 150-mile path, which USA Today 10Best ranks as one of the top-five recreational trails the nation - begins in Pittsburgh and crosses the Laurel Highlands before ending in Cumberland, MD. Each year, more than a million users enjoy the trail, with many cyclists connecting to the C&O Canal Trail in Maryland to ride all the way to Washington, D.C. – 330 miles from Pittsburgh.

A strong cultural connection binds Pittsburgh to the Laurel Highlands as well. GO Laurel Highlands and Discover Westmoreland partner with the Carnegie Museums of Pittsburgh, including the Natural History and Art museums. Meanwhile, visitors to Pittsburgh are drawn to architectural marvels in the Laurel Highlands, including Frank Lloyd Wright's Fallingwater, Kentuck Knob and Polymath Park.

It's easy to see why more visitors to the Laurel Highlands come from Pittsburgh than any other location and why the bond between the city and the region is only growing stronger.

FOR THE BIRDS

Your Guide to Birding in the Laurel Highlands

WHAT TO SEE

Large birds such as bald eagles, blue herons and red-tailed hawks are popular, but the Laurel Highlands is home to some more obscure species that appeal to birdwatchers, such as snow buntings, sora and pileated woodpeckers.

The biggest bird that can be found in the Laurel Highlands might also be its grandest. The bald eagle – America’s national emblem since 1782 – has become a common sight here over the past few decades.

“Decades after DDT was outlawed, the bald eagles are nesting in many hundreds of locations throughout Pennsylvania, including the Laurel Highlands,” says Jim Kellam, an ornithologist with Saint Vincent College in Latrobe who holds a doctorate in biological sciences. “All major rivers have them, as well as large reservoirs like Quemahoning.”

The bald eagle has a wingspan of 80 inches and weighs about 9.5 pounds, making it the largest bird in the region. Some other large birds that call the Laurel Highlands home include the great blue heron (72-inch wingspan, 6.4 pounds), turkey vultures (67 inches, 4 pounds) and red-tailed hawks (49 inches, 2.4 pounds).

Nearly 300 species of birds have been found in the Laurel Highlands, with about 130 of those appearing most years.



Birding Basics

WHAT TO KNOW

If you're a newcomer to birding, Kellam suggests getting a pair of mid-range binoculars – such as the 8x42 combination of magnification and lens size – to help spot birds and an app for your phone, such as the Cornell Lab of Ornithology's Merlin app, which can identify birds by calls and songs.

"It's about 95% accurate and it's an excellent learning tool," he says. "Birding in the summer is almost always done by ear because you simply can't see many birds up in the leafy trees."

WHERE TO GO

Looking for a great place to birdwatch? Here are some of Kellam's top recommendations:

- **Powdermill Nature Reserve** – great for woodland species such as warblers, vireos, woodpeckers and thrushes. A hike up the Porcupine Ridge Trail to the overlook is taxing, but it's worth it in terms of both birds and natural beauty. Powdermill also has a museum exhibit that is open to the public, and the Avian Research Center is one of the oldest bird-banding operations in the nation.
- **Keystone State Park** – Davis Run Trail features a variety of woodland species, plus there's the lake that hosts a different set of birds such as osprey, herons, cormorants, kingfishers and flycatchers.
- **Flight 93 National Memorial** – Many grassland species live here, including sparrows you won't see anywhere else. A pond along Approach Road almost always delivers a surprise, such as a swan, a duck or a sandpiper.
- **Ohiopyle State Park** – The diversity of habitats attracts a range of bird species. Check out the cliff swallows that live under the Route 381 bridge that crosses the Youghiogheny River, and then walk around the Ferncliff Peninsula to find vireos, kinglets and warblers. Try to take less popular trails to find a quiet, undisturbed forest to hear the musical song of the wood thrush.

Getaways on the Greens



As the world's best golfers gather in southwestern Pennsylvania, 2025 is the perfect time to recognize the special place that the Laurel Highlands holds in the sport.

Arnold Palmer, one of the true giants of the game, was born and raised in the Laurel Highlands, and the first golf course he designed – **The Peninsula Golf Club**, which was known as Indian Lake Golf Club – is now open to the public. Combined with **Northwinds Golf Course**, which is less than two miles away, and a stay at the **Lodge at Indian Lake**, Peninsula makes for a great weekend of golf.

Another popular stay-and-play option in the Laurel Highlands can be found at **Chestnut Ridge Golf Resort and Conference Center** in Blairsville, which features a pair of picturesque courses as well as the on-site Hampton Inn & Suites by Hilton. **Tom's Run Golf Course** has been ranked as the fifth-best public course in Pennsylvania, while **Chestnut Ridge Golf Course** offers breathtaking views.

Nearly a decade after his death, Palmer's presence

is still felt in the Laurel Highlands. **Arnold Palmer's Latrobe Country Club** – the course he grew up playing – bears the name of the seven-time major champion, as does Arnold Palmer Regional Airport in Latrobe, which includes a statue of The King.

Palmer's longtime friend Dick Groat, owned **Champion Lakes Golf Course** in Bolivar before his death in 2023. Champion Lakes has been ranked as one of the top 50 public courses in the U.S., and on-site lodging is available for multiple-round stays.

Highlands Ventures Outdoor Sports includes two courses – the **Highlands Golf Club at Seven Springs** and the **Highlands Golf Club at Hidden Valley**. The clubs offer a high-level experience on pristine courses without the country club expenses.

Nemacolin is home to two of the best public courses in America. **Mystic Rock**, which hosted a PGA Tour event from 2003 to 2006, and **Shepherd's Rock** are both open to guests staying at the 2,200-acre resort in Farmington. The Pete Dye-designed courses are as challenging as they are beautiful.



Whether you want to call it *blended travel*, *bleisure (business + leisure)* or a *mullet trip (business in the front, party in the back)*, more and more travelers are looking to combine work and fun while traveling.

conference to check out Pennsylvania's largest ski resort with 33 slopes and 10 lifts. Hop on the Alpine Slide for a thrilling downhill ride during warmer months or take advantage of one of the resort's signature events such as the Rib & Wing Festival, Wine Festival or Autumnfest, which was recognized as one of the top Fall Festivals by USA Today readers. Laurel Highlands POUR TOUR

The Laurel Highlands Pour Tour just keeps getting bigger and better.

More than 50 craft beverage makers were featured partners in Pour Tour 4.0, and thousands of individuals participated in the popular tour by picking up a paper passport or using a digital app to get a sticker or digital stamp each time they made a purchase.

From moonshine to merlot to Monongahela rye and pale ales to porters, there's something to please almost every palate on the Laurel Highlands Pour Tour.

With breweries, wineries, distilleries, cideries and even a meadery spread across a 3,000-square-mile region, it's never difficult to find a refreshing beverage.

Bonfires, Barrels and Brews, which launched in 2023, makes it even easier to taste the Laurel Highlands, as Pour Tour partners and participants gather each fall for a celebratory event. With a bevy of beverage makers on hand, participants can gather several stickers/digital stamps in one location.

CELEBRATE THE AREA'S WHISKEY HERITAGE ON THE LH POUR TOUR

Raise a glass to the birthplace of American whiskey in the region that made it famous.

Long before Kentucky became known for bourbon, Monongahela rye – distilled right here in the Laurel Highlands – was what 19th century Americans meant when they spoke of whiskey. Today, local distillers are embracing their rye roots.

In 2024, **West Overton Village & Museum** opened the James B. Beam Pennsylvania Whiskey Heritage Center in conjunction with Suntory Global Spirits, which produces Overholt, the longest-standing American whiskey brand.

West Overton is where Abraham Overholt began distilling in 1810 and is considered the “spiritual home” of his namesake brand. Located on the second floor of the museum in Scottdale, the Heritage Center includes the Sam Komlenic Gallery, which is home to the largest publicly accessible collection of artifacts related to Pennsylvania’s history of whiskey production, with more than 450 objects on display. The Overholt Stateroom, a vintage-inspired lounge, features a modern bar, antique furniture and decor, vintage and modern bottlings, and a mural of Abraham Overholt.

The museum includes an educational distillery and even distills its own brand of Monongahela rye whiskey, which can be purchased on-site. While most American whiskeys are corn-based, rye is used in the distilling process to create a deep, rich and full-bodied flavor profile.

Ponfeigh Distillery in Somerset also celebrates Monongahela rye’s important role in the region’s history. Located in a former 84 Lumber building, Ponfeigh has the largest capacity for any distillery in Pennsylvania. While Ponfeigh’s 20,000-foot property opened in late 2023, Maximillian Merrill began the distilling process three years earlier. He shipped locally grown rye to a sister facility in North Carolina, where it was distilled using the process that Ponfeigh now uses, and the product was aged in oak barrels for three years.

Ponfeigh has since added a tasting room and event center and plans to add an amphitheater and whiskey museum so that the brand, whose name comes from a Welsh word meaning “watering place of deer,” not only honors the region’s whiskey history but adds to it.
