



Notes

- The house has uneven floors and bumps to watch out for, including when transitioning from room-to-room. Some doorways and hallways are narrow.
- There is some street noise toward the front of the house, but it is generally quiet and not crowded.
- Wheelchair lift behind house to access first floor with assistance. Second floor is not accessible.
- There are many windows which allow natural light to enter the house.

- Restrooms are located out back in the garden. There is a big step down to access them. Two single occupant gender-neutral bathrooms: one has a changing table.
- Outside brick pathways can be bumpy and uneven in garden.
- No audio tours available. All the rooms have plaques to read. There are talking guided tours available.
- Coloring books and puzzles available for children.
