


Notes

- **Path to Overlook:** path to trailhead is mulched, and one section is gravel
- **Overlook:** flat area to stand or sit, cliff area could be dangerous, small path to waterfall is very rough and poorly defined
- **Red Trail:** uneven, can be slippery, trailhead has many uprooted branches, overlook area is rocky and requires careful foot placement
- **Blue Trail:** narrower, more inclines, and uneven grassy paths; path opens up as you approach Nature Sanctuary
- **Freedom Trail:** short, paved path starts from parking lot
- There are many signs to help you find the paths, but it is recommended that you take a photo of the trail map or get a pamphlet from the Front Desk.

- **All Terrain Action Trackchair** is available for free rental to enjoy the trails. Reservation times are available now at lexingtonky.gov/ravenrun.

Users will be accompanied by a guide who is able to offer assistance with the chair. A dedicated trackchair trail map will guide users on which trails are accessible with the chair and route options at the park.
