

Haunted LINCOLN &

With so much history surrounding the city, it should come as no surprise that Lincoln is the subject of a plethora of spooky stories. The site of many bloody sieges, beheadings and battles, the old cobbled streets here are filled with spine-tingling tales just waiting to be discovered...

Whether you believe in ghosts or not, many of these haunting stories offer a fascinating insight into the city's past. From headless bodies to, erm, bodyless heads, there are a whole host of ghost stories that centre around Lincoln's historic attractions.









LINCOLN CASTLE

Walk the castle walls after dark, and you may well see a lone rider and his horse. This ghost is said to be the friend of a local lord, who was wrongfully sentenced to death for a crime he didn't commit. The rider tried to save his friend with a pardon from the King, but arrived too late. His ghost continues to charge the castle today, trying to finish the journey he couldn't complete in life.



HOBBSONS PIE SHOP

Formerly known as Browns, this popular pie shop on Steep Hill is home to one of Lincoln's most famous hauntings. Thought to be a young boy called Humphrey, this meddlesome spirit has been known to run around the building, disrupt the kitchen and generally cause mischief wherever he goes. To stay on his good side, the first member of staff to arrive in the morning has to say hello to him!

LINCOLN GHOST WALK

Led by an expert ghost hunter, this award-winning experience will take you on a spooktacular tour around the Cathedral Quarter. Starting at 7.00 pm from Castle Square, tours run from Wednesday – Sunday, throughout the year. No booking is required, admission applies.

LINCOLN GHOST BUS

Join ghost enthusiast Karen Crow for a frightful journey past Lincoln's most haunted landmarks. With stories of prisoners, phantoms and poltergeists, this tour will keep you on your toes! GREESTONE STEPS

Following the death of St Hugh, parts of his body were sent to cathedrals across the country. His head was sent to Lincoln, where it was placed in a chest laden with gold and jewels. When thieves stole the chest, they tripped down Greestone Steps, spilling the contents onto the ground. Many people have reported hearing the head rolling behind them, and hitting the back of their legs...



THE WHITE HART HOTEL

Located in the historic Bailgate, the White Hart Hotel is said to be one of the most haunted buildings in Lincoln. There are many ghost stories surrounding the hotel; one of which relates to an 18th century highwayman. After attempting to rob a coach, this cut-throat thief was set on fire by the owner. Since his untimely death, both staff and guests have reported seeing the highway man striding through the hotel, hiding his burns with his cloak.



CHRISTMAS in LINCOLN







Christmas is one of the most magical times to visit Lincoln. From November onwards, the city is aglow with festive lights, the shop windows are adorned with sparkling displays and the scent of roasting chestnuts fills the air.

Whether you're shopping for presents, or catching up with friends, this beautiful city is the perfect place to kick off your celebrations.

Start your journey in the vibrant city centre, where you will find a whole host of shops, bars and restaurants. In the run-up to Christmas, there will be a variety of events taking place here, from pantomimes to pop-up markets. Thor's Tipi Bar will also be returning to Lincoln this year, with a roaring log fire and menu of festive drinks.

For a delightfully Dickensian experience, follow the twinkling lights up Steep Hill to the Cathedral Quarter. Lined with historic architecture and characterful shops, these cobbled streets wouldn't look out of place in a Christmas movie.

As well as an abundance of photo opportunities, you'll find some amazing independent shops here and plenty of places to stop for a cheeky hot chocolate or two.
