## SWING SONG BRISTOL LIGHT FESTIVAL

**Location:** City Square **What3words**: <u>///dreams.tribes.bumps</u> **Postcode**: LN5 7ET



## **Accessibility Information**

- There is step free access to this installation.
- The ground is hard standing concrete slabs.
- This installation features sound, with music playing throughout the experience.
- There are flashing coloured lights at this installation.
- Each individual swing has a weight load of 150kg, and the seats are 570mm wide.
- Unfortunately, a wheelchair-accessible swing is not available at this time. However, wheelchair users can still fully enjoy the installation's immersive lighting and sound.
- Children under 16 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- Each participant's session on the swings lasts for five minutes. Dwell time approximately 10-30 minutes.
- Walk-up queues are expected to have an approximate wait time of 30 minutes, though during peak times, the wait may be longer.

## Accessibility Information

- There is step free access to this installation.
- The ground is hard standing concrete slabs.
- There is sound at this installation, which is gentle and at a low level.
- There are no rapid flashing or strobing lights at this installation, the inflatables are illuminated from inside.
- Dwell time 10-15 minutes.

## Accessibility Information

- There is step free access to this installation.
- The ground is hard standing concrete slabs.
- This is an interactive piece with a PA system playing dancing music.
- There are low positioned flood lights projecting multiple colours that will move with the moving silhouettes
- There are no rapid flashing or strobing lights at this installation.
- Dwell time 15-20 minutes.
- During busier times, there may be a 10–15 minute wait time to interact with the installation.

- There are no rapid flashing or strobing lights at this installation.
- There are no sudden loud noises within the audio.

## **Accessibility Information**

- There is step free access to this installation at each location.
- The ground consists of hard-standing concrete slabs and cobbles.
- Certain areas along the trail, particularly on Steep Hill, have a steep gradient reaching 16.12 degrees (14%).
- Two projections are situated at the top of Steep Hill, while the remaining four are in fully accessible locations.
- The installation is visual-only, featuring projected images with no sound.
- Each projection has a dwell time of approximately two minutes.

- UV lights will be used to activate the unique badge designs.

- Accompanying audio and live performance.
- There are no strobing lights at this installation.
- This show includes live fire effects, such as fire cans and propane beacons.
- Dwell time approximately 15-20 minutes.
- Walk-up queues are expected to have an approximate wait time of up to 10 minutes, though during busier times, the wait may be longer.

- Walk-up queues are expected to have an approximate wait time of 10 minutes, though during busier times, the wait may be longer.

The new Tesla Centre Lincoln is offering free, stylish, electric transport to whisk visitors between the top and bottom of the trail during the event. Simply head to the pick-up and drop-off points at City Square and Minster Yard (outside the Cathedral). No need to book - just arrive and hop into one of the sleek Tesla electric cars (queue times may vary) for a short ride up or down the hill during the festival opening times! However, please note that this service may not be suitable for wheelchair users or for families with children who require a car seat.
