Getting here

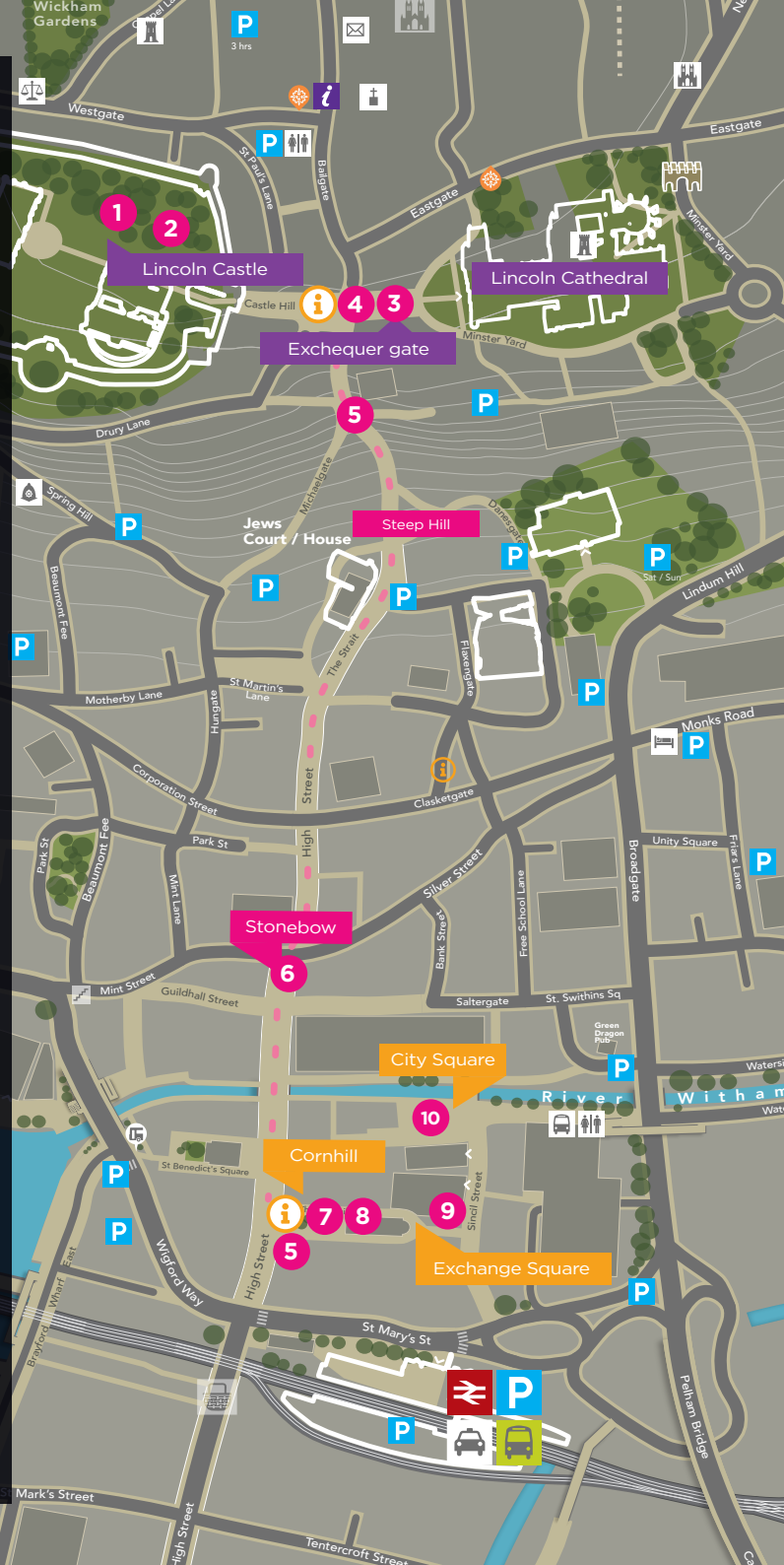
Lincoln is easily accessible by car, bus, or train. Once you arrive, the festival trail is located in the pedestrianised city centre, making it perfect for exploring on foot.
