


Live Music Venues

Tucked away in the Baltic Triangle, this intimate venue is a haven for underground music fans and boundary-pushing beats.


Future Yard

M&S Bank Arena


The M&S Bank Arena sits right on the waterfront and draws huge touring names, Florence and the Machine, Gorillaz and James are taking to the stage in 2026.






Explore The Beatles Story









Football Fever

At Anfield, the legendary home of the Liverpool FC Men's team, you can step behind the scenes on a stadium tour and then explore The LFC Museum, immersing yourself in the club's rich history from past to present.





For those who don't mind heights, you can take on the Anfield Abseil. Take in views out from across the Main Stand before heading on a 100ft abseil down past Liverpool's famous crest.

ByAir


Touch down just a few miles from the action at Liverpool John Lennon Airport. Hop on a direct airport bus or grab a private transfer and be in the city centre in no time.

- · Heading to the Wirral? The M53 is the way to go




By Rail
